And you shall observe the Feast of Weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the *Feast of Ingathering* at the year's end.

Exodus 34:22

"Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year: "You shall keep the Feast of Unleavened Bread (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty) "and the Feast of Harvest, the firstfruits of your labors which you have sown in the field; and the *Feast of Ingathering* at the end of the year, when you have gathered in [the fruit of] your labors from the field. Exodus 23:14 - 16

And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim [to be] holy convocations, these [are] My feasts.'Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day [is] a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work [on it]; it [is] the Sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings. 'These [are] the feasts of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. Leviticus 23:1-4

Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In the seventh month, on the first [day] of the month, you shall have a sabbath-[rest], a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.'You shall do no customary work [on it]; and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.' " Leviticus 23:23-25

And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: "Also the tenth [day] of this seventh month [shall be] the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. And you shall do no work on that same day, for it [is] the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you. before the LORD your God. Leviticus 23:26-28

"For any person who is not afflicted [in soul] on that same day shall be cut off from his people. "And any person who does any work on that same day, that person I will destroy from among his people."You shall do no manner of work; [it shall be] a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. "It [shall be] to you a sabbath of [solemn] rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth [day] of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath."God.' " Leiviticus 23:28-32

Lev 23:33 NKJV - Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Lev 23:34 NKJV - "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'The fifteenth day of this seventh month [shall be] the Feast of Tabernacles [for] seven days to the LORD. 'On the first day [there shall be] a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work [on it]. '[For] seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. On the eighth day you shall have a holy convocation, and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It [is] a sacred assembly, [and] you shall do no customary work [on it]. Leviticus 23:33 - 36

These [are] the feasts of the LORD which you shall proclaim [to be] holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day--'besides the Sabbaths of the LORD, besides your gifts, besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill offerings which you give to the LORD. 'Also on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep the feast of the LORD [for] seven days; on the first day [there shall be] a sabbath-[rest], and on the eighth day a sabbath-[rest]. Leviticus 23:37-39

'And you shall take for yourselves on the first day the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days.'You shall keep it as a feast to the LORD for seven days in the year. [It shall be] a statute forever in your generations. You shall celebrate it in the seventh month. 'You shall dwell in booths for seven days. All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths, 'that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I [am] the LORD your God.' " Leviticus 23:40 - 43

Deu 16:13 NKJV - "You shall observe the Feast of Tabernacles seven days, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress.



Deu 16:16 NKJV - "Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread, at the Feast of Weeks, and at the Feast of Tabernacles; and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed.

Deu 31:10 NKJV - And Moses commanded them, saying: "At the end of [every] seven years, at the appointed time in the year of release, at the Feast of Tabernacles,

2Ch 8:13 NKJV - according to the daily rate, offering according to the commandment of Moses, for the Sabbaths, the New Moons, and the three appointed yearly feasts--the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the Feast of Weeks, and the Feast of Tabernacles.



Ezr 3:4 NKJV - They also kept the Feast of Tabernacles, as [it is] written, and [offered] the daily burnt offerings in the number required by ordinance for each day.

Jhn 7:1 NKJV - After these things Jesus walked in Galilee; for He did not want to walk in Judea, because the Jews sought to kill Him.

Jhn 7:2 NKJV - Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand.

Jhn 7:3 NKJV - His brothers therefore said to Him, "Depart from here and go into Judea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You are doing. Jhn 7:10 NKJV - But when His brothers had gone up, then He also went up to the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.

- Jhn 7:37 NKJV On the last day, that great [day] of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.
- Jhn 7:38 NKJV "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."
 Jhn 7:39 NKJV But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet [given], because Jesus was not yet glorified.
