The United Church of God is announcing a job opening for a full-time Mail Fulfillment Clerk. Duties include:

- Process incoming mail/literature requests from both the Internet and USPS.
- Maintain and update the address database and be responsible for the accuracy and integrity of the address data.
- Fulfill requests for daily and weekly literature orders.
- Receive office mail and make deliveries as needed.

In addition, this role will perform donation processing functions for the Financial Services department—including opening mail and processing donations, tabulating donations, data entry, preparing bank deposits, and processing change of address requests for donors and members.

The incumbent must be a baptized member (in good standing) of the United Church of God, *an International Association*, with an associate's degree (A.A.) from a two-year college or institution and six months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
