

22 FULFILLED PROPHECIES & 22 PROPHECIES LEFT TO BE CARRIED OUT

The Fall Feasts are upon us – picturing the return of Christ and the establishment of the kingdom of God. Good time to analyze world scene. He admonishes us to be *alert* concerning world events so they will not *surprise* us. A lot is happening now and have people concerned – great storms, earthquakes and rumors of deadly wars. As Jesus Christ warned, “But *take heed* to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and the cares of this life, and that Day come on you *unexpectedly*. For it will come as a *snare* on all those who dwell on the face of *the whole earth*. *Watch* therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to *escape* all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man” (Luke 21:34-36)

Paul also reminded us: “But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief... Therefore *let us not sleep*, as others do, but let us *watch* and be sober” (1 Thes. 5:4-6). Peter adds, “And so we have *the prophetic word* confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts...” (2 Peter 1:19).

1.	Pre-eminence <i>since 1800</i> of <i>Great Britain & the U.S.</i> and to a lesser degree the <i>rest of modern Israel</i> (Gen. 49; Lev. 26; Deut. 33) until its moral decline and lesser dominance as unstable nations obtain nuclear bombs.	12.	<i>Population explosion</i> – At time of Christ – 200 million; year 1,000 - 400 million; in 1800 – 1 bil.; in 1900 – 1.6 bil.; in 2,000 – 6 bil.; now we have 7.5 billion (Mat. 24:37; Gen. 6:1-8, Rev. 9:16).
2.	U.S. & Great Britain would lose many of their strategic foreign ports and influence to maintain world peace; pride of power broken (Gen 22:17; Lev. 26:19; Dt. 28:57-63).	13.	Mortal threat to the Earth due to air, soil and water pollution because of man's rapacity. “You will die in a polluted land” (Amos 7:17, KJV; Rev. 11:18).
3.	Fulfillment of the <i>Sixth Resurrection</i> of the Holy Roman Empire – with <i>Hitler & Mussolini</i> from 1922-1945 (Rev. 13 & 17).	14.	Great worldwide <i>moral degeneration</i> : heinous crimes & perversions commonplace (Dan. 8:23; Lk. 17:26-28 (Noah's & Lot's day); 2 Tim. 3:1-6).
4.	<i>Knowledge explosion</i> from 1900 on with the discoveries of Edison, Bell, Wright brothers, Einstein, Thomas Watson (IBM), Watson & Crick (DNA); Google, A.I. – (Dan. 12:4).	15.	Increase of <i>political and military instability – frequent military overthrows</i> and <i>extreme terrorist groups</i> causing fear in all (Is. 3:5; Mt. 24:12; Mk. 13:8; 2 Tim. 3:1-6).
5.	Enormous increase in <i>world transportation</i> : land (cars: 1 bil.), water (53,000 a day) and air (planes: 100,000 a day) -- (Daniel 12:4).	16.	Increase of papal power and influence from Rome to the rest of the world (Rev. 13; 17-18).
6.	Establishment of <i>Israel 1948 & Jerusalem</i> as Jewish capital 1967 (Mt. 24:15-16)	17.	Multiplication of the destructive power of war – nuclear & biological bombs (Mat. 24:7, 21-22).
7.	<i>Middle East</i> becomes the focus of <i>constant conflicts</i> (Zec. 12:2-3; Luke 21:20-24).	18.	Reappearance of great plagues around the world – such as AIDS; ebola, cholera, etc. (Mat. 24:7).
8.	The rise of <i>Islamic power</i> – a confederation is formed (Daniel 11:40-43; Psalm 83).	19.	Increase number and intensity of earthquakes and hurricanes (Mk. 13:8; Lk. 21:11).
9.	Formation of a <i>European Union</i> with multiple rulers--currently Great Britain is out of this system (Dan. 2:40-44; Rev. 13: 17).	20.	Rise of droughts and large famines in parts of the world (Mt. 24:7; Lk. 21:11).
10.	<i>Unification of Germany</i> that becomes pre-eminent power in Europe (Isaiah 10:5-34).	21.	Proliferation of religious sects; the occult, witchcraft and Satanism (1 Tim. 4:1-2; Mt. 24:24).
11.	Capacity of man to <i>destroy</i> all of humanity – by nuclear, bacteriological and chemical armaments – (Mt. 24:22; Mk. 13:20).	22.	The true gospel of the kingdom is again heard around the world and would continue to spread until the very end (Mt. 24:14; Mk. 13:10).

In 1 Thes. 5:20 it says, "Do not *despise* prophecies." While it is not spiritually healthy to dwell **only** on prophecy, for close to 2/3 of the Bible deals with other important subjects, we should not ignore them. After reviewing 22 prophecies that have basically been fulfilled, let's analyze the 22 prophecies that are yet to be carried out. These are the most probable scenarios as we presently understand Bible prophecy.

1.	Something dramatic occurs to the world's economic & military system , with the center of power more in Europe (Rev. 13, 18).	12.	The Church flees to its place of refuge for 3 1/2 years (Mt. 24:15-21; Rev. 3:10; 12:14-17).
2.	Rise of the king of the North, also known as the Beast – a political & military leader (Dan. 2:40-44; 8:23-25; 11:31-45; Rev. 13, 17).	13.	The Mark of the Beast becomes compulsory during the Great Tribulation (Rev. 13:5, 13-17). People will think only way to get jobs & safe.
3.	Satan's great rebellion against God fails and he is cast out with his angels to the earth and has 3 1/2 years left (Revelation 12:7-14).	14.	European attack against Russia (and possibly other parts of Asia), the first woe begins (Dan. 11:44-45; Rev. 9:1-12).
4.	A new world economic order arises in Europe under 10 rulers and the Beast (Dan. 8:23-25; Rev. 17-18).	15.	Russian (& possibly Asians) counter-attack European Union - second woe begins (Rev. 9:13-21).
5.	The False Prophet appears with miraculous powers to deceive, with his helpers (Dan. 11:39; Mt. 24:24; Rev. 13; 16; 17). Demons will use others as well (R. 16:13-14).	16.	Asiatic invasion reaches area of Israel (Rev. 9:14-16; 16:12-16). The collective mindset of the Asians helps gather such an army of 200 million (in 1900 pop. 1.6 billion).
6.	The king of the South, very likely under Islam, appears on the world scene and will provoke a war with the nations under the rule of the king of the North (Dan. 11:40-12:1).	17.	Angels pour out the Seven Last Plagues (or Bowls) upon the entire earth, yet people refuse to repent (Rev. 16).
7.	Sacrifices will begin in Jerusalem (Dan 8:11-25; 12:9-11; Mt. 24:15-22; Rev. 11:2).	18.	Gathering of the earth's armies at the valley of Armageddon in Israel (Revelation 16:13-16).
8.	The Two Witnesses arise: 2 especially chosen Church leaders (Zec. 4:14; Rev. 11:1-13).	19.	Great signs appear in the heavens (Mt. 24:29; Rev. 12:12-16).
9.	European invasion of Israel and the Middle East region (Daniel 11:40-44).	20.	Christ returns to the earth & nations lament (Mt. 24:30-31; Rev. 19:11-16).
10.	The Work of the Church finishes its stage of spreading Gospel to world (Amos 8:11-12; Is. 55:6; Mt. 24:14; Mk. 10:13; Rev. 12:13-17).	21.	He defeats the rebellious armies around Jerusalem and becomes king of kings on the earth ((Zec. 14:1-21; Rev. 19:17-21).
11.	Jerusalem is conquered and the sacrifices are halted. The abomination of desolation is set up (Daniel 8:11-25; 12:9-11; Mt 24:15-22; Luke 21:20-24; Rev. 11:2).	22.	Satan is bound for a 1000 years and is cast into a prison-like pit. God's 1000 yr. reign begins on the earth! (Revelation 20:1-6).

We should remember four mandates as we near the final stages of the end times:

1. We should continue to *reject* this world's *false value and religious system* to avoid the punishment that will come upon the entire earth (Rev. 3:10; 18:4-5)
2. We should continue to *simplify* our lives and not be swallowed up by the crass materialism around us. We should enjoy physical things, but not let them become the center of our lives. We should live like we will die of old age, but prepare as if God begins to intervene strongly tomorrow (Mt. 16:26; 24:44-51).
3. Prepare ourselves to become *teachers* of God's ways, learning the most in Church to become faithful servers and leaders now and in the Kingdom of God (Is. 11:9; Dan. 12:3; Rev. 20:6).
4. Humbly strive to become an integrated part of the Bride of Christ, maintaining the unity of the faith and the spirit of service in the Church (Ephesians 4:10-16; Rev. 19:5-9).
