Is the WHO Agreement a Big Step to a World Government?

The parent body of the World Health Organization's (WHO) is the United Nations (UN), and the UN is openly seeking a global government through all areas of life via a global transformation. On Tuesday, May 20, 2025, member countries of the globalist medical control system WHO adopted an international "Pandemic Agreement" with virtually no country objecting. 124 voted in favor with 11 abstaining. This globalist body described the document as a "historic pandemic agreement to make the world more equitable and safer from future pandemics." In reality, the agreement binds member countries to a single WHO-directed response to future pandemics, effectively instituting a global medical dictatorship. Satan is subtle, and he slowly is nudging us towards a world government. Given the authoritarian climate created in national and state governments because of Covid 19, when there is another great pandemic, imagine how fast the world could descend into a total dictatorship.

Will the United States pull out of WHO?

The U.S. has not pulled out of the WHO. Instead, it has been absent from the annual World Health Assembly for the first time in nearly 80 years due to President Trump's plans in his first term to withdraw from WHO membership. However, this withdrawal was reversed by President Biden when he took office in 2021. The U.S. continues to support the WHO financially, being one of its largest contributors. The United States in 2024-2025 was the largest contributor to the World Health Organization, contributing around 958 million U.S. dollars. Trump may move to withdraw in his second term.

The Pandemic Agreement states on page 11: "The Parties shall promote a One Health approach for pandemic prevention, preparedness and response, recognizing that the health of people is interconnected with animal health and the environment, that is coherent, integrated, coordinated and collaborative among all relevant organizations, sectors and actors, as appropriate, in accordance with national and/or domestic law, and applicable international law, and taking into account national circumstances."

As World War II was winding down, nations were in ruins and the people of the world yearned for a means of achieving a permanent peace. Representatives of 50 countries gathered in San Francisco, California April 25 to June 26, 1945. For two months they proceeded to draft and then sign the UN Charter, which created a new international organization, the United Nations, which, it was hoped, would prevent another world war like the one they had just endured. There has never been a world government with executive, legislative, and judicial functions and an administrative apparatus; the UN formed in 1945 remains the closest thing to a world government, as it is by far the largest and most powerful international institution. The tentacles of the UN now extend around the globe, and it wields much power. The International Monetary Fund (IMF) is a financial arm of the UN, and its purpose is to promote international monetary co-operation, facilitate international trade, foster sustainable economic growth, and make resources available to member nations experiencing balance of payments difficulties. The United States is the largest cumulative contributor to the IMF, with contributions amounting to \$155 billion. The IMF gives the UN considerable financial control over nations facing challenges.

Americans question the benefit of the UN

The view of Americans has changed over time. Many view the UN with a measure of doubt and concern, especially regarding its influence and effectiveness in global affairs. Overall, the US's relationship with the UN often reflects a balance between international cooperation and preserving its own national sovereignty to achieve its strategic goals. The United States contributes approximately 22% of the UN's regular budget and up to 28% of the peacekeeping budget. In 2024, the U.S. was the largest financial contributor, covering \$ 674.2 million of the total UN budget. However, in 2025, the U.S. is expected to pay 26.15% of all UN peacekeeping costs. The second largest contributor to the UN is Japan at \$ 253.1 million.

Covid-19 brought the world grinding to a halt. By August 2020, the greatest public health emergency of the century, thus far, had nearly 20 million infected people and claimed over 730,000 lives across all inhabited continents, bringing public health systems to their knees, and causing shutdowns of borders and lockdowns of cities, regions, and even nations unprecedented in the modern era. The greatest surprise during the time of the pandemic was the unmistakable regression into authoritarianism in national and state governments and how quickly the tone and mentality of government leadership changed almost overnight, even in Democratic countries. It became a time when force was used if one did not get the Covid-19 vaccine, and this did not take mandates from an international organization, but by the orders of the U.S. Center for Disease Control (CDC). All the CDC had to do is recommend masks indoor and outdoor, 6-foot distancing, or taking multiple Covid-19 shots, and people did it.

Research has revealed that serious effects of taking the vaccine are being found. On the website, nypost.com, the New York Post reported, “Top federal health officials actively took steps to “delay warning the public” for months in 2021 about the potential risks of heart-related complications from receiving mRNA COVID-19 vaccines, a scathing interim report from Sen. Ron Johnson’s office alleges. Starting in February 2021, federal health agencies had been alerted to “large reports of myocarditis” in young people who received the Pfizer vaccine, but waited until late June that year to adjust the vaccine labels to make that side effect known. Even though CDC and FDA officials were well aware of the risk of myocarditis following COVID-19 vaccination, the Biden administration opted to withhold issuing a formal warning to the public for months about the safety concerns, jeopardizing the health of young Americans,” the 54-page interim report said.”

Thousands of people lost their jobs because they refused to be vaccinated. Across the country employers fired workers for refusing to comply with vaccine mandates. Some people were opting to quit their jobs rather than take the shot. 3,400 troops were involuntarily separated from service for refusing to get the COVID-19 vaccine. The Marine Corps by far kicked out the most service members: 1,968 total, with only 20% of whom received an honorable discharge. Teachers and even doctors and nurses were expelled from their jobs, because they refused the vaccine. Employers, in an effort to enforce mandates, became authoritative and took drastic actions often robbing citizens of the right to make decisions about their own bodies.

A study revealed that roughly more than 100,000 small businesses in the United States had to permanently close their doors for good during the coronavirus outbreak lockdowns. The shutdown of these businesses meant people lost their livelihoods and the ability to support themselves and their families. During the Covid-19 pandemic, within weeks, more than a million Canadians lost their jobs and were left scrambling to survive in the new normal.

Travelers had to be tested for Covid-19 to fly anywhere. Some states were more stringent than others. In Hawaii, you had to be tested flying from one island to another. The jury seems to still be out as to whether the vaccine really prevented anyone from getting Covid-19. Most all the people I know who took the Covid shot got the virus anyway, and some multiple times.

Of course, it was mandated also that you had to wear a mask to prevent contraction of the disease or spreading the virus. Some think masks do not prevent contracting Covid at all. However, *Newsweek* said, “Cloth masks were associated with a 56 percent lower risk, while surgical masks were associated with a 66 percent lower risk. Respirators were the most effective, linked to an 83 percent lower risk.”

If the Covid pandemic had not been abated, it is possible that we would have, even in countries with democracies, been required to show our “papers” wherever we traveled, like in Nazi Germany. While WHO with its Pandemic Agreement does not seek authority over sovereign nations at this time, the Covid pandemic has shown it may not be necessary for WHO to have that kind of authority; even democratic nations might leap quickly into a dictator mentality which forces its citizens to obey, as evidenced by the power in the U.S. by the CDC during the pandemic.

There has been a call for world government for some time now, and the Bible says it will come (Revelation 13:11-18). The World Economic Forum openly advocates and works for it. Right now, there is a resistance to it in the United States, and some are fighting against it. This may necessitate that the United States will have to be destroyed to make way for a world government. Is it possible the new international Pandemic Agreement made by the WHO is just one big step needed, to make way for the arrival of a world government?
