The Shocking Muslim plot to Invade Europe

The Muslim Brotherhood was founded in Ismailia, Egypt in 1928 by Hassan al-Banna. In the 1960s, Said Ramadan and other migrants settled in Europe and started to establish networks to spread their ideology.

A shocking French report has shown there has been a conspiracy hatched by the Muslim Brotherhood to invade Europe. The report says: “An explosive report from the French government alleges the Islamist Muslim Brotherhood network has embarked upon a decades-long effort to forge a fifth column in France and across Europe through infiltrating government institutions and radicalizing Muslim communities, while veiling their true intentions with supposedly noble causes such as fighting ‘Islamophobia’.”

A prominent Stanford University public policy think tank, the Hoover Institute, reported on their official website, hoover.org: “In the last 20 years, both violent and non-violent forms of Islamism have increased dramatically in Europe. France alone has witnessed more terrorism than elsewhere on the continent -- some 30 incidents in the last 10 years alone, such as the dramatic attacks on the Bataclan theater in Paris and the offices of the Charlie Hebdo publisher in Paris in 2015 and the beheading of French school teacher Samuel Paty in 2020, as well as in Nice and Marseilles. Other attacks have taken place in Brussels, Vienna, Berlin, London, Manchester, Copenhagen, Amsterdam, Turku, Frankfurt, and Kongsberg, leaving hundreds of innocent people dead, injured, or scarred for life...”

What does all of this portend for the future?

The Islamization of Europe is bad for the United States

It was addressed at hoover.org: “US policymakers have generally not paid close attention to the Islamism phenomenon. All administrations have worked well with European governments to combat terrorism and ‘counter violent extremism,’ particularly since 9/11. US embassies and consulates have engaged extensively with Muslim groups. The prevailing view in Washington, however, has been that Islamism is a concern but is primarily a European problem. This assessment is not wrong, but the trends have negative implications for US national security. European leaders need to combat Islamism more rigorously and US policymakers should also not treat it only as Europe’s problem. Of the estimated 5000 persons who traveled to Syria from Europe to join ISIS in the 2010s, more than 2000 were from France and radical ideology has inspired many to commit violent acts at home. Knife attacks have become an everyday phenomenon, with particularly egregious cases in Algeciras, Duisburg, Mannheim increasing by nearly 40 percent from 2021 to 2023, to 14,000 in Germany alone...Not all of these cases had a proven Islamist aspect, but a very large percentage did. Non-violent expressions of Islamism are also common. Banned symbols of terrorist organizations (IS, Hamas, Hezbollah) appear regularly in public...”

The Hoover Institute report continues: “These manifestations have increased in number since October 7, 2023 and include widespread protests against Israel and ugly expressions of anti-Semitism. Pro-Gaza demonstrations with strong pro-Hamas undercurrents are commonplace. In May, demonstrators in Hamburg called for the caliphate as the ‘final solution’ for all Muslim struggles. During riots in the UK this summer, thousands of Muslims marched through London chanting, ‘Jews, remember Khaybar. The Army of Muhammed is coming to kill you, too.’ Many Jews feel the need to hide their identity lest they be attacked on the street, and emigration from France and the UK to Israel has reached new highs...”

Mass migration, including from predominantly Muslim states, has become more closely bound together in the way Islam is expressed. What Germany refers to as “parallel societies” are in fact forming all over Europe. The Muslim Brotherhood and other related organizations have strongly instructed Muslims to separate from and resist the host country’s religious culture.

“No go” areas of France and Germany: What about U.S. cities?

Muslims have created what some call “No-Go Zones” in many cities on the continent, a term former German Chancellor Merkel and others used, but others insist don’t exist.

The Gatestone Institute published a 120-page research paper titled, "No-Go Zones in the French Republic: Myth or Reality?" It documented dozens of French neighborhoods "where police and gendarmerie cannot enforce the Republican order or even enter without risking confrontation, projectiles, or even fatal shootings."

In these areas Sharia Law has replaced the laws of France and Germany. Plans call for an Islam-centric 402-acre neighborhood called EPIC City about 30 miles northeast of downtown Dallas in North Texas near Josephine; it is still in the planning stages of development. The *Dallas Morning News* reported they are hoping to build more than 1,000 homes, a K-12 faith-based school, a mosque, elderly and assisted living, apartments, clinics, retail shops, a community college and sports fields. Some are calling it, "Sharia City."

The data available does not state the number of Muslims moving into the USA each year, but it should be noted that 56% of Muslim immigrants in the United States have arrived in the last twenty-five years, since the year 2000. This indicates a continuous flow of new Muslim immigrants, contributing to the overall demographic growth of the Muslim community in the U.S.

Approximately 3.45 million Muslims call the United States home, making up about 1.1% of the total population. New York, NY is home to over a million Muslims. Sharia law is not officially recognized in New York, NY. Some community groups are allowed to enforce some aspects of Sharia law, such as community patrols. They do not have the authority to enforce Sharia law from a legal standpoint.

Dearborn, Michigan, has earned the reputation of being one of the most concentrated Muslim communities in the United States with a population of over 100,000 Muslims. With an estimated 500,000 Muslims residing in the greater Los Angeles area, the city boasts a dynamic Islamic landscape encompassing mosques, Islamic schools, and cultural centers. Sharia Law is not accepted in LA. While there are communities which practice Sharia law, it is not recognized as a legal system in the state.

Consider this, "no-go zones" are possible in the U.S. These are neighborhoods or communities where this could happen. The EPIC City project was halted. On Feb. 24, Texas Governor Greg Abbott pushed back hard to stop it from moving forward. Abbott posted on X this statement regarding the EPIC City project: "To be clear, Sharia law is not allowed in Texas," he wrote. "Nor are Sharia cities. Nor are 'no go zones' which this project seems to imply. Bottom line: The project as proposed in the video is not allowed in Texas."

So, already the U.S. is being impacted by what the invasion is bringing to Europe. *Newsweek* published an article on March 16, 2021, "Europe's Experience on Islamism Is a Cautionary Tale for the United States," which stated, "European nations are suddenly taking serious and significant action to push back in earnest against encroaching Islamist separatism and radicalization. And the United States, as an observer, stands to learn a lot."

Is Islam compatible with democracy?

Islamism in its radical forms is not harmonious with the Western ideology of democracy. Western nations must somehow control immigration into the country of those who harbor the ideas which the Muslim Brotherhood wish to bring about or there will be a collapse of the laws which distinguish our democracies.

In ancient times to be considered a part of the culture a person had to embrace the culture of the nation—not bring their own. When a foreigner came into Israel and they wanted to be a part of the nation and keep Passover, all the males had to be circumcised; then it was commanded, "*and he shall be as a native of the land*" (Exodus 12:48). God warned ancient Israel what could happen if they didn't obey His laws and control immigration. Moses wrote, "*The alien who is among you shall rise higher and higher above you, and you shall come down lower and lower. He shall lend to you, but you shall not lend to him; he shall be the head, and you shall be the tail. Moreover, all these curses shall come upon you and pursue and overtake you, until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the Lord your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you.*" (Deut. 28:43-45)

There will come, as prophesied, a time when the king of the south pushes at the king of the north. The king of the south will likely be a conglomerate of Muslim nations and the king of the north, a European-based beast system (Revelation 13:3-4).

How Muslims are being treated in Europe may play a major factor as to why the king of the south lashes out in anger at Europe. We can see even now how Muslims all over the world are angry and indignant as to how Gaza and Hamas are being treated by Israel. Similarly in the future, exasperated Muslims of the Arab and Muslim nations of the southern kingdom may start using deadly force against the king of the north; this may then cause Europe to come at them with a great force and conquer them (Daniel 11:40-42).
