Volunteer Opportunity to Serve in Proclamation of the Gospel in Europe: Would you like to actively support God's Work and help preach the gospel? We're looking for many English-speaking volunteers to assist in translating UCG literature into European languages—using a streamlined process supported by artificial intelligence.

Not everyone needs to know a foreign language to participate. There's no age requirement, and you can serve from the comfort of your own home using a personal computer and Internet connection. You can contribute as little or as much as your time allows.

Key roles include:

- o Initial Layout – Format English documents for translation.
- o Scripture Review – Replace AI-translated verses with accurate Scriptures from the approved Bible translation (e.g., NKJV). This is a simple but crucial step, and training is provided.
- o Proofreading – Requires fluency in the target language to review and refine translations.
- o Final Layout (*coming soon*) – Upload and finalize content for our new UCGEurope.org website.

We especially need help with Scripture Review in Czech, Estonian, Latvian, Norwegian, Polish, Romanian, Russian, Swedish and Ukrainian. We also need native-speaking proofreaders for these and other European languages.

Job Opening Announcements

Outgoing Mail Processing Clerk and Warehouse Assistant – Part Time

The United Church of God has announced an opening for a part-time Outgoing Mail Processing Clerk and Warehouse Assistant. Primary responsibilities will include:

- Processing outgoing mail to domestic and international areas.
- Receiving goods and supplies, office deliveries, literature shipments and other materials from USPS, UPS, DHL and FedEx.
- Monitoring and reporting on warehouse inventory of mailing supplies, office supplies and Church literature.
- Running mailroom equipment and machinery.
- Transporting outgoing mail from the office to the post office via truck and/or van.
- Fulfilling other duties as assigned.

A high school education is necessary, and strong language, math, logic, reasoning and communication skills are required. The incumbent must frequently lift and/or move up to 40 pounds. This job also requires standing for extended periods of time. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and the ability to adjust focus.

Potential employees must be baptized members (in good standing) of the United Church of God. Applicants must be biblically literate and possess a thorough working knowledge of the doctrines, beliefs and practices of the United Church of God.
