The Bible Knowledge Commentary mentions, “The doors on the street are shut. This refers, of course, to the ears. Everything has to be repeated over and over. Loud noises, like the grinding of the mill, are very low and indistinct. The old man suffers from insomnia; he rises up bright and early, when the first bird begins to chirp or the rooster crows. All the daughters of music are brought low; the vocal chords are seriously impaired. The voice is crackling and unsteady, and song is out of the question.”
