The live webcasts of the Feast services will start Monday evening October 6, 2025 (none that evening for Temecula), and end on Tuesday, October 14, 2025.

FREE LIVE PHONE SERVICE AVAILABLE FOR THE FEAST

A free live phone service will be available for those who need to listen to the Feast of Tabernacles church services on their phone from services in Temecula or Morehead City, North Carolina (the schedule for Temecula is above).

Registration – A person may register their phone number by calling the toll-free number 888-858-8266 and following the prompts to register their phone number, be added to the calling list and to receive a call from the United Church of God when services start.

The same number can also be used to listen directly to the live phone stream if audio is available. Caller ID will show 888-858-8266 or "UCG Sabbath."

In case the phone number is disconnected, the individual can call the toll-free number 888-858-8266 to rejoin.

Sabbath Thought

Ecc. 12:7, "Then the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it." A modern version put it, "Your body came from the earth, and when you die, it will return to the earth. But your spirit came from God, and when you die, it will return to him" (ERV).

Here we see an important biblical truth – when you die, it's not your "soul" that survives, but "the spirit" that returns to God. It's not active, conscious or alive, but simply it's all the person's identity that is stored in heaven until a future resurrection. As Christ said as He died, "'Father, 'Into Your hands I commit My spirit'" (Luke 23:46). Paul added, "And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us" (Heb. 11:39-40). The dead in Christ are still "asleep" until they are awoken and "perfected" (human nature is removed and God's perfect nature is placed instead."

If you don't have a pre-labeled green envelope, you can write in your "Beyond Today" number (begins with a "U" and can be found at near your name on the mailing label). All offerings will be mailed to the Home Office. The location is Orange County, CA. There will be a box in the back of the hall for offerings if you will not be attending the morning service. NEW: REUSABLE, ONLINE HOLY DAY OFFERING CARDS

Donating on the UCG website is a secure and convenient way to give a Holy Day offering. It also saves time for our processing team and helps ensure accuracy.

However, we understand that some brethren may feel uncomfortable letting the offering basket pass by without physically placing something in it. To help with this, the home office has provided reusable online offering cards for each congregation.

These cards display a QR code that can be used to submit an offering online. If you choose to donate online, you may take a card before services, make your offering online, and then return the card by placing it in the offering basket as it passes. This allows for a meaningful physical gesture even when giving digitally.

Of course, if you prefer to give using a traditional green envelope, you're still welcome to do so during Holy Day services.
