The live webcasts of the Feast services will start Monday evening October 6, 2025 (none that evening for Temecula), and end on Tuesday, October 14, 2025.

**Registration** – A person may register their phone number by calling the toll-free number 888-858-8266 and following the prompts to register their phone number, be added to the calling list and to receive a call from the United Church of God when services start.

*The same number can also be used to listen directly to the live phone stream if audio is available. Caller ID will show 888-858-8266 or "UCG Sabbath."*

### *Sabbath Thought*

**Eccl. 12:8**, "'Vanity of vanities,' says the Preacher, 'All is vanity.'" *Wiersbe's Commentary* mentions, "For the last time in his discourse, the Preacher said, 'Vanity of vanities...all is vanity.' The book closes where it began (Eccl. 1:2), emphasizing the emptiness of life without God. When you look at life 'under the sun,' everything does seem vain; but when you know Jesus Christ as your Savior, 'your labor is not in vain in the Lord' (1 Cor. 15:58).

As *Nelson's Commentary* adds, "The refrain of vanity—the brevity of life—is here repeated. It is possible that the book originally ended with these words." If this is the case, Solomon, who eventually left God, retained some of his wisdom, but it was not connected anymore to God's spirit, and thus, life became boring, passing and meaningless.

We read in 1 Kings 11:4-6, "For it was so, when Solomon was old, that *his wives turned his heart after other gods; and his heart was not loyal to the Lord his God*, as was the heart of his father David. For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. *Solomon did evil in the sight of the Lord*, and did not fully follow the Lord, as did his father David."

You can also get an offering envelope from the ushers. Please make checks payable to United Church of God (or UCG) and remember to write the amount legibly on the front of the envelopes. If you don't have a pre-labeled green envelope, you can write in your "Beyond Today" number (begins with a "U" and can be found at near your name on the mailing label). The location is Orange County, CA Individual donation amounts will be mailed to the Home Office and receipted by them.

### NEW: REUSABLE, ONLINE HOLY DAY OFFERING CARDS

Donating on the UCG website is a secure and convenient way to give a Holy Day offering. It also saves time for our processing team and helps ensure accuracy.

However, we understand that some brethren may feel uncomfortable letting the offering basket pass by without physically placing something in it. To help with this, the home office has provided reusable online offering cards for each congregation.

These cards display a QR code that can be used to submit an offering online. If you choose to donate online, you may take a card before services, make your offering online, and then return the card by placing it in the offering basket as it passes. This allows for a meaningful physical gesture even when giving digitally.

Of course, if you prefer to give using a traditional green envelope, you're still welcome to do so during Holy Day services.
