Eccl. 12:5, “Also they are afraid of height, and of terrors in the way; when the almond tree blossoms, The grasshopper is a burden, and desire fails. For man goes to his eternal home, and the mourners go about the streets.”

As *The Bible Knowledge Commentary* points out, “Being afraid of heights and of dangers in the streets points up lack of vigor and the fear that makes older people afraid to venture out. The almond tree blossoms refers to the hair turning gray and white (almond blossoms are white). The grasshopper drags himself along speaks of the body being bent and one’s walk being slowed. Desire no longer is stirred speaks of diminished appetites. The decline of physical powers culminates in death and man goes to his eternal home (i.e., the grave) and people grieve (mourners go about in the streets).”
