The City offers multiple options for downtown parking to fit a variety of needs:

- Parking Permits (see prices below)
- Meters (per hour \$2 Mon-Thu \$4 Fri-Sun)
- Parking Lot Passes (\$400 annual)
- Free Parking Lots (Lots D & E)

PARKING PERMITS/STICKERS

RESIDENT.....FREE/2YRS

Eligibility: Any resident homeowner or resident tenant with a current vehicle registration and current utility bill that proves residence within City limits. Name on registration must match name on utility bill. (4 FREE STICKERS)

Additional stickers.....\$25.00 each

Expiration: December 31, 2025

BUSINESS OWNER......\$50/2 YRS/2 Max

Eligibility: Business owner holding a valid business license to operate in the City limits of Lake Geneva. Bring current vehicle registration. Price is prorated in the second year of issue.

Expiration: December 31, 2025

WALWORTH COUNTY RESIDENTS.....\$160/2 YEARS

Eligibility: Resident of Walworth County with a current vehicle registration and current utility bill that proves residency in Walworth County. Name on registration must match name on utility bill. Price is prorated in the second year of issue.

SENIOR DISCOUNT: Show photo ID as proof of 65

years or older.....\$130/2 YEARS Expiration: December 31, 2025

Permits allow you to park or move to any metered stall within a 3 HOUR CONSECUTIVE block of time without paying the meter. Additional time MUST be paid at meter. TO BE VALID PERMITS/STICKERS MUST:

- Be fully adhered & visible on the lower left hand driver's side
- Sticker must match license plate
- Sticker is non-transferable

PARKING LOT PERMIT.....\$400/YEAR

Parking Lot Passes ONLY allowed in (A) Cook Street Lot; (B) Center Street Lot; & (G) Geneva Street Lot. Must bring vehicle registration for primary holder.

METERED PARKING

The City has a pay-by-plate parking program. Please check signage on parking signs throughout downtown and pay upon parking at nearest pay station with coins, Visa/MC/Discover, parking app, or by phone.

> PARKING METER HOURS ENFORCED 9 A.M. to 7 P.M. DAILY

OVERNIGHT PARKING IS ALLOWED IN: (D) Sage Street lot for a period of time NO longer than 24 consecutive hours. Please call the Lake Geneva Police non-emergency number at (262) 248-4455 for further information.

SNOW PARKING RULES-METERED STALLS

Vehicles may not park on the street until the snow has been plowed to the curb line.

FREE PARKING: NOVEMBER 15 - JANUARY 31 PAID PARKING: FEBRUARY 1-NOVEMBER 14
