World's Top State Sponsor of Terrorism Iran Denounces 'Lawless Marauders' U.S. at U.N.

September 25, 2025 breitbart.com reported: "Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian claimed that Iran does not seek to build a nuclear weapon, citing a non-existent 'fatwa' against it, and condemned 'aggressor' Israel during his address to the United Nations General Assembly on Wednesday.

Pezeshkian spent much of his address presenting Iran as a nation subjected to 'savage aggression' by Israel, which he also accused of committing 'genocide' in Gaza and 'destabilizing' the region as part of several actions that are allegedly part of a purported 'Greater Israel' plot. Pezeshkian prefaced his speech by calling upon a 'golden maxim' of 'That which you would not approve for yourself, do not approve for others,' citing related phrases from Christianity, Islam, and Judaism before condemning Israel..."

German pizza store bans all Israelis until they 'open their eyes' to Gaza

September 25, 2025 timesofisrael.com reported: "A pizza store in Fürth, Germany, has caused outrage by banning all Israeli customers in protest against the war in the Gaza Strip, local media reported Wednesday.

The local Jewish community in the southeastern state of Bavaria denounced the move as a throwback to the antisemitism of Nazi Germany, while the Israeli Embassy in Berlin also said it showed a return to the 1930s.

The owner of the store, identified by Israel's *Ynet* outlet as Pizza Zulu, confirmed to the media that he had put up a poster banning Israelis, but insisted it was not intended to be antisemitic.

An image of the poster, which was displayed in the entrance to the store, was circulated on social media.

'We believe that the children of this world should not be harmed under any circumstances,' it read. 'We are part of civil society and will therefore not stand idly by like the rest of the world. That is why we have decided to protest. Our protest has no political, let alone racist, character.'

'Israeli citizens are not welcome in this establishment,' it continued. 'Of course, they will be welcome again as soon as they decide to open their eyes, ears, and hearts.'

Rubio Urges Russia's Lavrov to Stop 'Killing' in Ukraine

September 25, 2025 moscowtimes.com reported: "The top U.S. diplomat Marco Rubio issued a blunt call to his Russian counterpart to halt the 'killing' in Ukraine Wednesday, as Washington's stance on Moscow hardened.

Rubio 'reiterated President [Donald] Trump's call for the killing to stop and the need for Moscow to take meaningful steps toward a durable resolution of the Russia-Ukraine war,' State Department spokesman Tommy Pigott said..."

Taliban rejects Trump's attempt to regain control of Bagram Air

September 24, 2025 spacewar.com reported: "The Taliban government has rejected President Donald Trump's attempt to regain control of Bagram Air Base, which the United States abandoned to the Afghan government during its military withdrawal from the Middle Eastern country four years ago.

The United States left the country in a hasty exit that was initiated under the first Trump administration and completed under the Biden administration, which saw Afghanistan fall back under Taliban control.

Last week, Trump publicly demanded the facility be returned to U.S. control in a bid to check China. The Taliban on Sunday said that it is seeking 'constructive relations' with all states and that it has consistently communicated to the United States that Afghanistan's 'independence and territorial integrity are of the utmost importance.'

'It should be recalled that, under the Doha agreement, the United States pledged that 'it will not use or threaten force against the territorial integrity or political independence of Afghanistan, nor interfere in its internal affairs.' Therefore, it is necessary that they remain faithful to their commitments,' the Taliban said in a statement shared by its deputy spokesman, Hamdullah Firat, on X..."

Over three-quarters of Israelis believe in Trump plan to end Israel-Hamas War

September 24, 2025 **jpost.com** reported: "Nearly 80% of the Israeli public supports a political initiative led by US President Donald Trump to end the war in Gaza, a Tuesday poll from the Israeli Coalition for Regional Security found.

According to the poll, 78% of Israelis would support a Trump-led political initiative, provided that it would end the war, return all hostages, disarm Hamas, normalize relations with Saudi Arabia, pave the way for separation from the Palestinians, and establish a regional security coalition against Iran.

The poll came as Trump addressed the United Nations General Assembly on Tuesday and called for an end to the war in Gaza and the release of all of the hostages.

'We have to stop the war in Gaza immediately. We have to negotiate immediately,' he said..."

Defeat of the Iranian axis is 'within our means,' says Netanyahu

September 23, 2025 **jpost.com** reported: "Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu discussed war objectives for the coming year in an address to Defense Minister Israel Katz, IDF Chief-of-Staff Lt.-Gen. Eyal Zamir, during a meeting with members of the IDF General Staff Forum in Tel Aviv on Monday.

Netanyahu urged that in pursuit of achieving security and overcoming Israel's enemies, 'we need to destroy the Iranian axis... this is what stands before us in the coming year, which could be a historic year for the security of Israel.'

The defeat of the Iranian axis of terror proxies across the region 'is within our means,' said the prime minister..."

Especially in France' -- ISIS Calls on Muslims to Kill 'Christians and Jews' in Europe by Any MeansSeptember 22, 2025 breitbart.com reported: "ISIS reportedly called upon Muslims to use any means necessary to kill 'Christians and Jews' in the United States and Europe, with a specific focus on France, in an edition of its Arabic-language magazine.

Although the so-called Islamic State has lost its physical Caliphate after it was defeated under the first Trump administration, ISIS radicals continue to advocate for their strict interpretation of the Islamic religion and seek to influence impressionable young Muslims in the West to commit acts of terror in its name.

In a copy of its al-Naba obtained by the Centre for the Analysis of Terrorism (CAT) and shared with the French paper of record *Le Figaro*, ISIS wrote: 'O monotheistic Muslims... Hit Jews and Christians, their crowds and convoys, in the streets and on the roads of America and Europe, and especially in France. Do not spare them, attack them, kill them by all means: by car, with a knife, a gun or by causing a fire.'..."

UK, Australia, and Canada Recognize Palestine as a State

September 22, 2025 breitbart.com reported: "The United Kingdom, Canada, and Australia announced on Sunday they now recognize Palestine as a state, despite accusations that it would be rewarding the Islamist Hamas terrorists behind the October 7th terror attacks on Israel...

Starmer's telegraphed announcement was preempted by fellow G7 nation Australia and Canada, both of which announced Sunday they would also recognize the territory as a state shortly before Starmer's statement.

Starmer initially laid out plans to officially recognize Palestine in July on a conditional basis, demanding that Hamas — the Islamist terror group behind the

October 7th terror attacks on Israel in 2023, which saw over 1,200 murdered and around 250 hostages taken — disarm, release the hostages, and agree to give up control of Gaza.

Despite these conditions not being met, Starmer said on Sunday, 'In the face of the growing horror in the Middle East, we are acting to keep alive the possibility of peace and of a two-state solution'..."
