**REMINDER – Qualified Charitable Distributions:** We wish to share some important information regarding the use of *Qualified Charitable Distributions* (QCDs) when donating as part of your Holy Day offerings.

QCDs are distribution of funds from an individual's Individual Retirement Account (IRA) payable directly to a qualified 501(c)(3) charitable organization such as the United Church of God, *an International Association* (UCGIA). QCD donations are unique in that they require UCGIA to identify them specifically as QCDs and provide acknowledgement letters to donors instead of receipting them as we would a non-QCD cash donation.

If you choose to use a QCD to make a Holy Day offering, we ask for your assistance as follows:

- Please do not place them in your local congregation's Holy Day offering collection.
- Instead, remit the Holy Day QCD donation directly to UCGIA: United Church of God, P.O. Box 541027, Cincinnati, OH 45254-1027.

- *Ensure the donation is clearly labeled as a QCD and the Holy Day offering to which it applies.*

**New BT/UCG Streaming App Coming Soon:** The home office I.T. and Web development teams are working hard to enhance our set-top video streaming apps for the Church. As a result, you will start to see some changes very soon. In particular, the [Beyond Today streaming app](#) will be getting a brand-new interface with some great new options. And, it will appear on almost every streaming platform.

What had been the separate “United Church of God” streaming app will be phased out and integrated into the *Beyond Today* app. The new app will be a joint BT/UCG application—integrating everything both the *Beyond Today* and United Church of God apps have—plus more.

The new BT/UCG app will host the weekly Cincinnati PM webcast and will also feature the two official Feast of Tabernacles webcasts. Consequently, this will also mean United Church of God video material will be available not only on Roku and Amazon Fire TV, but on all the streaming platforms that support *Beyond Today*—greatly expanding the audience for our UCG sermon and Bible study videos.

We will provide more details as the app update gets closer. If you are currently using the UCG app, consider also installing the current *Beyond Today* app if you haven’t done so already, which will automatically update when the new version is published.
