Sabbath Thought

Eccl. 12:9, "And moreover, because the Preacher was wise, he still taught the people knowledge; yes, he pondered and sought out and set in order many proverbs."

Nelson's Commentary notes, "It is possible that he speaks of himself here in the third person (as in Eccl.1:1-2). Probably it was an editor under the guiding hand of God who wrote these evaluations of Solomon, much as Joshua or some other editor wrote an evaluation of Moses under the influence of God's Spirit (Deut. 34). pondered ... sought out ... set in order: The three verbs that describe Solomon's activity may also be translated "weighed ... examined ... and arranged."

It is probable, but not certain, that there was an editor, possible Ezra, under God's spirit, who added the epilogue to this book so it would not end so negatively. Nehemiah, 400 years later, still gave a negative assessment about Solomon, saying, "Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? Yet among many nations there was no king like him, who was beloved of his God; and God made him king over all Israel. Nevertheless, pagan women caused even him to sin" (Neh. 13:26).
