**Introduction to the Psalms (part 2)**

*Wiersbe's Commentary*

“The writers of about two-thirds of the psalms are identified in the superscriptions. David leads the way with seventy-three psalms. He was Israel’s ‘beloved singer of songs” (2 Sam. 23:1 NIV) and the man who organized the temple ministry, including the singers (1 Chr. 15:16; 16:7; 25:1). The sons of Korah, who served as musicians in the temple (1 Chr. 6:31; 15:17; 2 Chr. 20:19), wrote eleven psalms (42–49, 84, 85, 87), Asaph twelve psalms, King Solomon two (Ps. 72 and 127), Ethan wrote one (Ps. 89), and Moses one (Ps. 90).”
