Sabbath Thought

Ecc. 12:13-14, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil."

Nelson's Commentary explains, "To fear God is one of the major themes of this book and of wisdom literature in the OT. To fear God is to respond to Him in awe, reverence, and wonder, to serve Him in purity of action, and to shun evil and any worship of anything else in His universe. keep His commandments: The commandments of the Law are in view here. Jesus summed them up as to "love the Lord your God" and "your neighbor as yourself" (Mat 22:34-40). Man's all: We are whole or complete only when we fear God and obey His commandments. What profit is there in living? If we follow what this Book has said, we will have a relationship with God and find life in Him."
