Putin says Russia considers resuming nuclear tests after Trump comments

November 6, 2025 spacewar.com reported: “Russian President Vladimir Putin said Wednesday that Russia would consider resuming nuclear tests if the United States did so, convening a security council meeting after US President Donald Trump’s comments on testing.

The statement marks the latest episode of nuclear saber-rattling between the world’s two largest atomic powers, after Putin and Trump failed to find ways to resolve the Ukraine conflict.



Putin ordered Russia’s defence and foreign ministries, as well as security services, to ‘gather information on this topic’ and make ‘proposals on the possible start of preparation works for nuclear weapons tests.’ Russia has not conducted a nuclear test since 1990, the year before the collapse of the USSR.

Trump said on social media last week that he had instructed the Pentagon to ‘start testing our Nuclear Weapons on an equal basis,’ with Russia and China. It was unclear whether he was referring to tests involving nuclear warheads or not...”

Former IDF general says Gaza ceasefire is temporary, predicts return to combat

November 5, 2025 ynetnews.com reported: “Brigadier General (Res.) Amir Avivi, founder and chairman of the Israel Defense and Security Forum, said Israel is preparing to resume military operations in Gaza once diplomatic efforts to dismantle Hamas fail, warning that the militant group is using the current lull to regroup and rearm.

In an interview, Avivi rejected characterizations of the situation in Gaza as a deadlock, describing it instead as part of a broader regional process involving the United States and moderate Sunni states.

‘President Trump wants to first build a coalition, then see how we dismantle Hamas,’ Avivi said. ‘I think he won’t manage to dismantle Hamas diplomatically. So, Israel is waiting and preparing for the moment when we’ll have to go in and finish the job.’

Avivi warned that time is not on Israel’s side during the current pause in fighting. ‘Hamas is getting stronger every day that we’re grouping. They’re arming, they’re planning attacks, they’re planning to kidnap soldiers. We can’t hold this situation for long,’ he said.

The general called for Israel and the United States to establish a deadline for diplomatic efforts, arguing that the current situation allows Hamas to strengthen while Israel focuses on other fronts...”

Report: Iran arming Iraqi militias ahead of clash with Israel

November 4, 2025 israelnationalnews.com reported: “Iran is increasing its support for Shiite militias in Iraq in anticipation of a potential future conflict with Israel, according to a report aired Tuesday morning on Kan Reshet Bet radio.

Iraqi sources familiar with the matter told Kan that following recent blows suffered by the pro-Iranian axis in Lebanon, Syria, and Gaza, Tehran is shifting its strategic focus toward strengthening its proxies in Iraq. These militias are reportedly receiving more advanced weaponry as part of this renewed effort.

The sources suggested that Iran is preparing these Iraqi factions for potential action against Israel should hostilities resume...”

Iran celebrates anniversary of 1979 US Embassy takeover with ‘Death to Israel’ chants

November 4, 2025 timesofisrael.com reported: “Iranians on Tuesday celebrated the anniversary of the 1979 takeover of the US Embassy in Tehran — the first such commemoration since the US bombed Iran’s nuclear facilities during a 12-day war with Israel in June.

On November 4, 1979, Iranian students overran guards to take over the embassy, seizing dozens of hostages in a crisis that would last for more than a year.

In what is a yearly commemoration, thousands of people returned to the spot in downtown Tehran on Tuesday chanting ‘Death to US’ and ‘Death to Israel.’ Some hanged effigies of US President Donald Trump and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and set fire to US and Israeli flags.

State media said similar gatherings took place in other Iranian cities and towns.

Mock-ups of Iranian missiles were on display on the sideline of the rallies, some inscribed with the words ‘Death to America.’ Replicas of centrifuge machines used in uranium enrichment were also on show.

Iran’s supreme leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei vowed Monday during a meeting with students that there would be no move toward normalizing ties with Washington soon — a message echoed on banners at Tuesday’s rallies…”

17 Nigerian Christians Killed in Attacks Hours After Trump Called Out Religious Persecution

November 4, 2025 breitbart.com reported: “At least 17 Christians were killed in Nigeria hours after President Donald Trump designated the nation as a Country of Particular Concern (CPC) for ongoing attacks by radical Islamists, with local media reporting ‘fresh attacks by gunmen across communities in Plateau and Kaduna states.’

A Friday evening attack in Kaduna claimed the lives of seven people and injured one more, with Nigerian outlet Punch reporting that the assailants ‘invaded’ the Damakasawa community in Chawai Chiefdom around 8:00 pm and began ‘shooting sporadically and forcing residents to flee into nearby bushes for safety.’

The chief of Chawai, Alhaji Yahaya Muhammad, told the newspaper that five of the fatalities died at the scene while the other two later succumbed to their injuries…”

Despite ceasefire agreement: Hamas terrorists attempt attack on IDF soldiers

November 3, 2025 israelnationalnews.com reported: “Earlier on Monday, the IDF identified terrorists who crossed the yellow line and advanced toward IDF troops in the southern Gaza Strip, posing an immediate threat to them.

Following the identification, the IDF, from the air and on the ground, struck the terrorists in order to remove the threat to the troops.

Responding to the incident, an IDF spokesperson said: ‘IDF soldiers in the Southern Command remain deployed in accordance with the ceasefire agreement and will continue to operate to remove any immediate threat.’ This is not the first time Hamas has violated the ceasefire…”

Iran vows to rebuild nuclear sites ‘stronger than before’

November 3, 2025 israelnationalnews.com reported: “Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian declared Sunday that Tehran would rebuild its nuclear sites ‘stronger than before,’ following Israeli and American strikes that targeted key facilities.

‘By destroying buildings… we will not be set back,’ Pezeshkian said in a video posted to his official website, as quoted by *AFP*, adding that Iranian scientists still possess the necessary nuclear expertise.

In June, Israel launched an unprecedented bombing campaign against Iran, targeting nuclear and military infrastructure. The US later joined in, hitting Iran’s key nuclear sites.

US President Donald Trump stated that the strikes ‘obliterated Iran’s nuclear program’. Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi later acknowledged that the damage was ‘serious and severe,’ following the US announcement of a halt in fighting…”
