**Feast of Tabernacles 2026 – Biblical Tour of Turkey:** We are excited to announce a festival tour for 2026 in Turkey. The 9-night program will span the entire Feast of Tabernacles with six of the nine nights being at an all-inclusive resort along the Icarian/Aegean Sea.

Attendees can start out with a pre-Feast tour of the ancient capital of Constantinople (modern day Istanbul). Then the Feast begins at Izmir (ancient Smyrna), continuing on to five of the seven churches mentioned in the book of Revelation. This promises to be biblically educational and a highlight Feast. Hotel accommodations and food will not disappoint. A post-Feast option to Cappadocia will also be available.

This will be an educational Feast focusing on biblical geography, the travels of Paul, early Christian congregations and the life and culture of the early Church—all with the rich meaning of the Feast of Tabernacles.
