Sabbath Thought

Ps. 2:7-8, “I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, today I have begotten You. Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.’”

Here is one of the instances where God the Father is called “Lord” or Yahweh and not just of Christ. *Wiersbe’s Commentary* says about Jesus the Messiah, “The enthroned King now speaks and announces what the Father said to Him. ‘I will declare the decree’ informs the rebels that God rules His creation on the basis of sovereign decrees. He doesn’t ask for a consensus or take a vote. God’s decrees are just (7:6), and He never makes a mistake. According to Acts 13:33, Ps. 2:7 refers to the resurrection of Christ, when He was ‘begotten’ from the tomb and came forth in glory (See Rom. 1:4; Heb. 1:5; 5:5).”
