

UCG-OC Sabbath at Irvine Regional Park



Plan to attend our 29th UCG-Orange County's Sabbath at Irvine Regional Park (in Orange) April 25, 2026 - Services at 11:00 a.m.

Please plan on coming to Irvine Regional Park in Santiago Canyon east of the main city of Orange on April 25 for UCG-Orange County's 29th Sabbath in the Park for our congregation plus some from the congregations of Los Angeles and Redlands. We have again reserved beautiful and large **Coyote Corner** with picnic tables over a compacted dirt base under a canopy of trees in God's creation, about a mile from the park entrance. This area is the most secluded of Irvine's group areas, with grassy areas on both sides. The restrooms are about 180' away.

Parking Lot O is right in front of our shelter. If this parking lot fills up, there are two parking lots adjacent or near our area (please look at the map on the reverse side). The parking lots are in alphabetical order which will help you locate ours. Please note that the Park entrance fee on weekends is \$5 per automobile (cash only).

Services will be at 11:00 a.m. followed by a deli-type sandwich lunch. The Orange County congregation will again be providing all the sandwich fixings. **Please bring (preferably) a salad or side dish OR a dessert.** A donation box will be there if you want to help defray some of the costs. After a delicious lunch together, you can continue to enjoy relaxing and fellowshiping in the afternoon.

Dress is nice casual (no shorts) or Hawaiian attire. You may bring your own lawn chairs if you would like and sit under the trees. Come and enjoy this special and relaxing Sabbath under the trees!

After lunch, enjoy fellowshiping with each other in nature until you want to leave. Please note that there will be no services at our regular church facility in Orange County that day.

Directions and Map

Irvine Regional Park is located in Santiago Canyon, in the east part of the city of Orange.

From the south you can take the Newport Freeway (#55) to the Chapman Avenue East offramp. Head east on Chapman for approximately five miles. Turn left on Jamboree for one fourth of a mile to the park entrance.

From the north you can also take the Katella Ave. exit from the 55 freeway. Katella becomes Villa Park Road which becomes Santiago Canyon Rd. Turn left at Jamboree which becomes Irvine Park Road.

There are other ways to reach the park, including going north on Jamboree or taking the 241 tollroad part of the way.
