

## 18 PARALLELS BETWEEN ISRAELITES' EXODUS & CHURCH'S EXODUS IN REVELATION

A MESSAGE FOR THE DAYS OF UNLEAVENED BREAD By Mario Seiglie, April 4, 2026

Brethren, the Days of Unleavened Bread not only picture the past, but also *the present and the future*. There are **18 parallels** between the **books of Exodus** and of **Revelation**. One book deals with the Exodus from Egypt & the other with the Church's end-time Exodus from this evil age (Rev. 18:4). **1 Cor. 10:1-13** tells us what happened to the Israelites are examples for us. Notice **Revelation**, just as **Exodus**, mentions oppression, plagues, fleeing, Egypt (as Jerusalem) & the song of Moses. Let's go over these parallels that apply in a personal, collective (as a Church) & prophetic way. (This chart is the best we know at this time, since God *always* has the last word.)

1	<b>Ex. 1:8-13, 21-22</b> – The account of Israel's oppression in Egypt and cries to God.	<b>Rev. 1:1-10</b> Prophetic account of Church's oppression during the Day of the Lord (TLV).
2	<b>Ex. 2:23-25</b> - Israel at end of Egypt's oppression when God is ready to intervene	<b>Rev. 2-3</b> - Stages of the Church until the end of this world's oppression when God acts.
3	<b>Ex. 3:9-12</b> - God calls <b>Moses</b> as liberator.	<b>Rev. 5:6-14</b> – <b>Christ</b> is the liberator.
4	<b>Ex. 4:21-23</b> - Israel's 12 tribes will be protected by God.	<b>Rev. 7:1-17</b> – Church as the 12 spiritual tribes of Israel are protected during this time.
5	<b>Ex. 7:1-5</b> – The team of <b>Moses &amp; Aaron</b> are the principal leaders doing miracles.	<b>Rev. 11:3-11</b> –The <b>Two witnesses</b> - principal leaders doing miracles <b>in the end times</b> .
6	<b>Ex. 7:8-13, 22</b> – Moses, Aaron vs. Pharaoh & magicians--miracles done by both teams.	<b>Rev. 11:5-6; 13:13</b> Two witnesses vs. Beast & False Prophet--miracles done by both parts.
7	<b>Ex. 7:14; 8:22-23; 9:25-26</b> - <u>10 plagues</u> hit Egypt but the last seven don't touch Israel.	<b>Rev. 15:8; 6:1-2</b> - The <u>7 last plagues</u> are poured on the earth but Church is protected.
8	<b>Ex. 12:21-23</b> - Israel wins through symbol of the lamb's blood on the doorposts.	<b>Rev 11:8, 15; 12:5, 17</b> Defiled Jerusalem is now <i>Egypt</i> . Church wins by Christ the Lamb.
9	<b>Ex. 13:3-5</b> - Israel flees to a temporary place of safety – the Sinai desert – 40 yrs.	<b>Rev. 12:13-14</b> – Start of 3 1/2 years, Church has to flee to a place of wilderness and safety.
10	<b>Ex. 14:21-23</b> – By God's power, Israel crosses the Red Sea to safety from Egypt.	<b>Rev. 12:15</b> – By God's power, the persecuted Church by Satan crosses into the wilderness.
11	<b>Ex. 14:23-26</b> - Pharaoh's army persecutes Israelites but perishes, swallowed by water.	<b>Rev. 12:16</b> - Beast's "army" (Rev. 17:15) under Satan is swallowed by earth & perishes.
12	<b>Ex. 14</b> Pharaoh loses, but is unrepentant.	<b>Rev. 12:17</b> Satan defeated, but unrepentant.
13	<b>Ex. 15:1</b> - Israel's victory hymn of Moses.	<b>Rev. 15:3</b> Church's victory hymn of Moses.
14	<b>Ex. 16:4-6</b> - Israel time of trial – 40 yrs.	<b>Rev. 13:5,7</b> Church's time of trial – 3 1/2 yrs.
15	<b>Ex. 16:12; Dt. 29:5</b> Israel nourished 40 yrs.	<b>Rev. 12:14</b> Church nourished for 3 1/2 years.
16	<b>Ex. 20-23</b> Israel at Mt. Sinai receives the Ten Commandments & other laws to keep.	<b>Rev. 14:12</b> - Church keeps commandments in letter & spirit, bears faithful witness to Christ.
17	<b>In Joshua</b> - God defeats Israel's foes.	<b>Rev. 19:19</b> - Christ defeats the Church's foes.
18	<b>In Joshua</b> (which ends Israel's exodus) God gives them the Promised Land.	<b>Rev. 20:4, 6</b> – God gives the kingdom of God to Christ and His Church through time.

Remember, the **Days of Unleavened Bread** ultimately look forward to the time when **righteousness will reign on a new earth and where sin will exist no more!** (2 P. 3:10-14).
