Nelson's Commentary brings out, “Be angry, and do not sin: These words are cited by Paul in the NT to describe ‘righteous indignation’ (Eph. 4:26). Here David exhorts his reader not to let anger or anxiety erode complete trust or faith in the Eternal. Offer the sacrifices of righteousness: These words speak of the salvation experience. Put your trust in the Eternal. Those being addressed here are the wicked (Ps. 1:4-6). Thus, in this psalm, the poet calls his neighbors to put their faith in God (Ps. 67).”
