**Family Discussion Points:** Read Leviticus 23:33-35 to your children. Why does God command us to abstain from work on His special Holy Days and Sabbaths?

The Feast of Tabernacles is one of the special Feasts that God made for us. The Bible tells us in Leviticus 23:41-42 that we are to keep this Feast year after year. And that each generation should observe it as well. So that means grandparents, parents and children too!

The children of Israel stayed in booths during the Feast. Today we stay in motels, tents or other types of temporary dwellings.

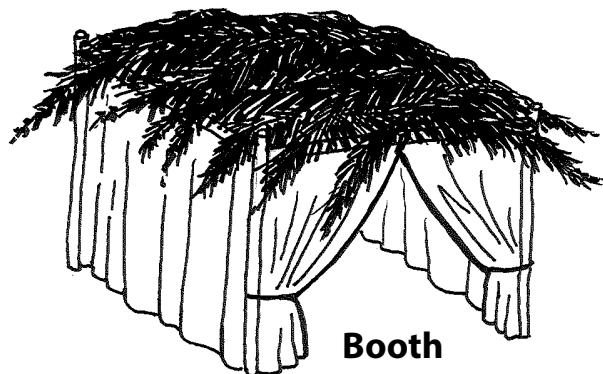

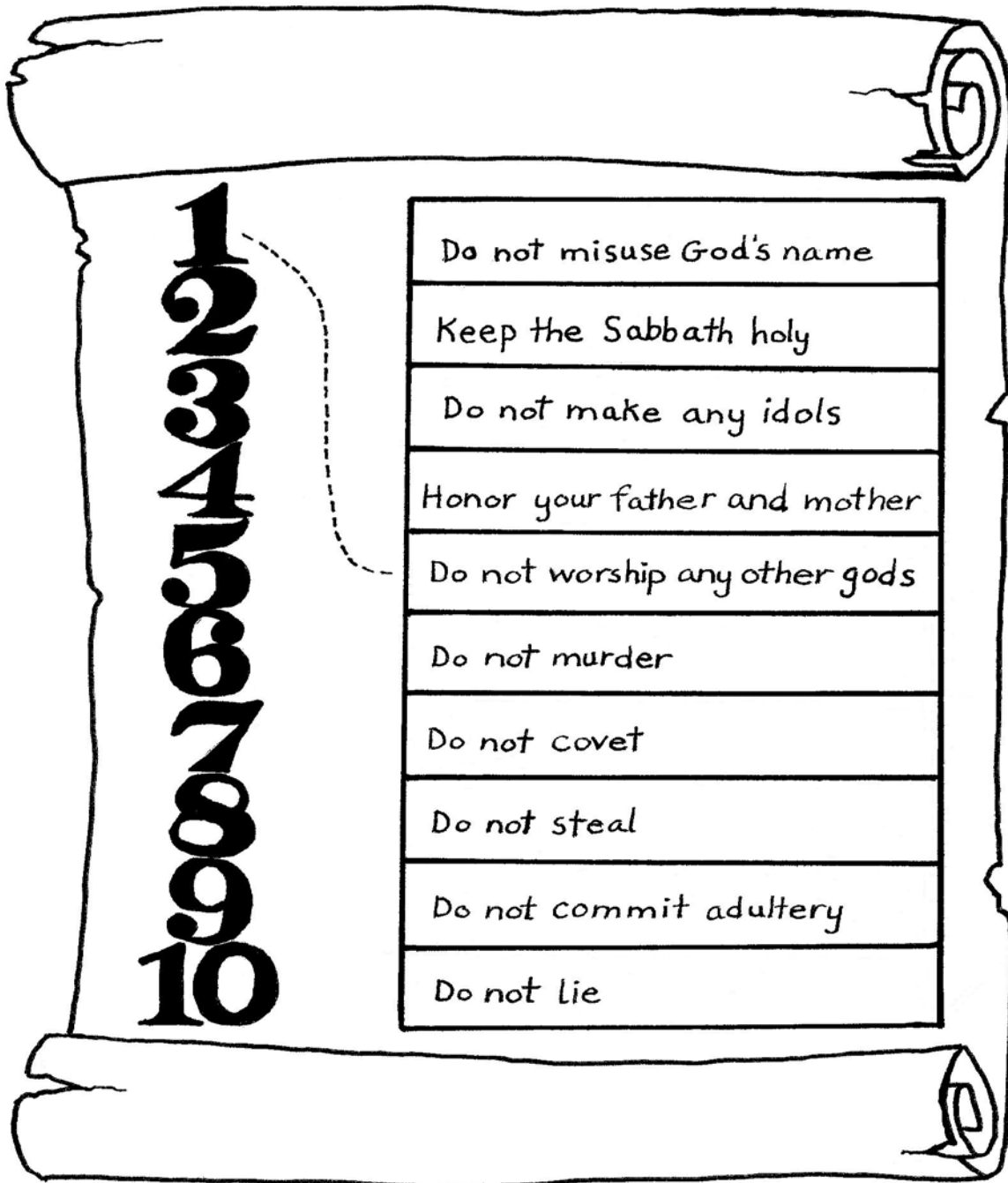
**Word Bank:** seven rejoice LORD you



**Family Discussion Points:** God wants us to rejoice at the Feast and experience special things such as good food and activities. What special traditions or activities does your family do during the Feast?

**Match the number to the correct commandment. The first one is done for you.**

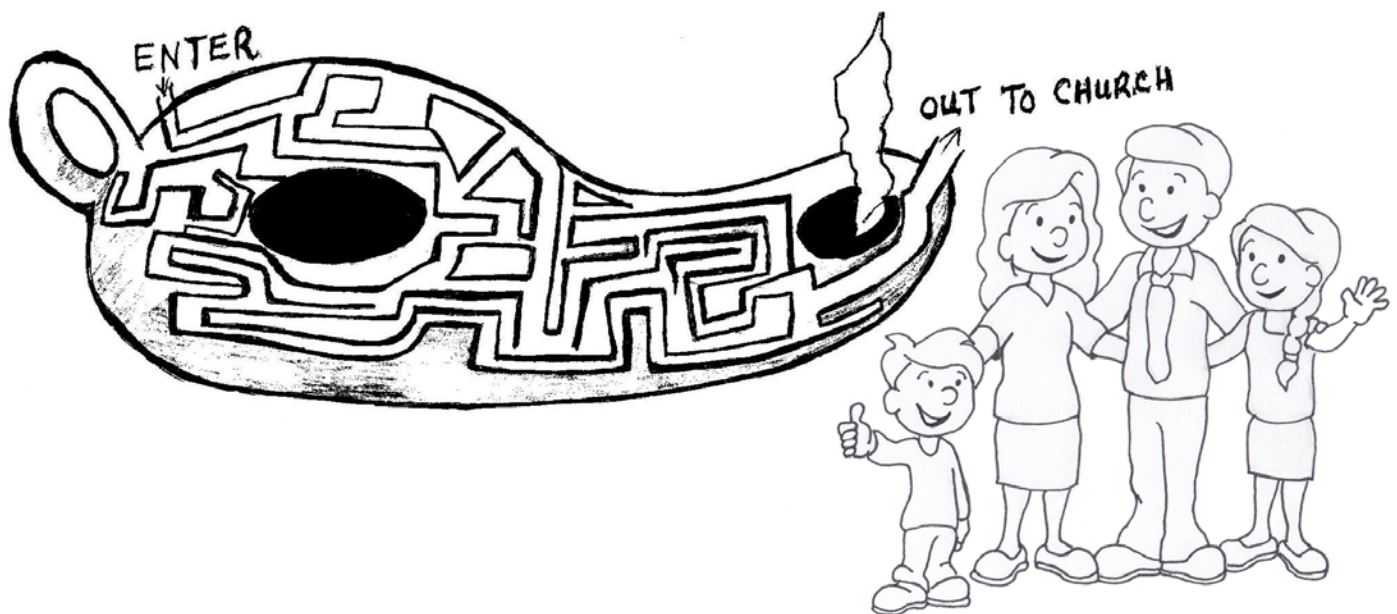


**Family Discussion Points:** Review the Ten Commandments with your family. Discuss why people in society today pick and choose which commandments they obey, if any. Will the people in the Millennium and God's Kingdom keep just some or will they keep all the commandments? Why?

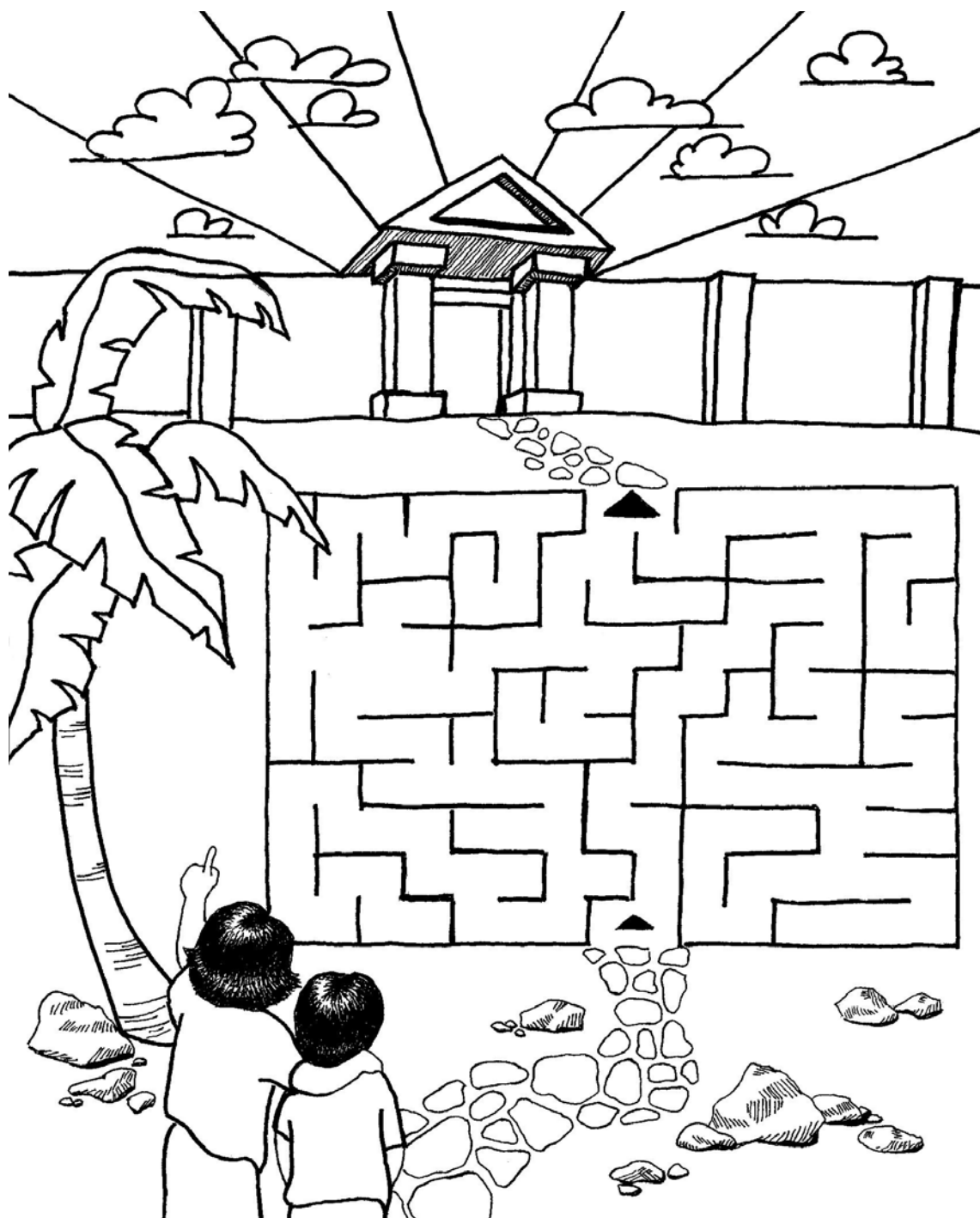
**Help the family choose the right path to church services!**



**Family Discussion Points:** Discuss with your family how God wants us to be close to Him. Discuss how we can draw close to God by meditating and studying His Word and praying to Him every day. Point out that during the Feast we should make studying and meditating on His Word a high priority!

Today we keep the Feast of Tabernacles where God places His name. When Jesus Christ returns to the earth all people will come to know the one true God and all of His ways. God the Father will require all people to go up to Jerusalem to worship Him and keep the Feast of Tabernacles. Can you imagine the whole world keeping the Feast at the same time? How exciting it will be!

**Family Discussion Points:** Read Zechariah 14:16-19 together as a family. What will happen to those families who disobey God and do not go up to Jerusalem to keep the Feast?

**Family Discussion Points:** Why do you think God punishes the families who refuse to keep the Feast? Do you think that is fair? Why or why not?

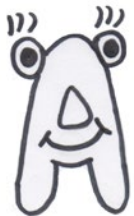

**Parent Discussion Points:** Read Isaiah 2:4 and Micah 4:3. How do the world governments today compare to how God's government will rule in His future Kingdom?

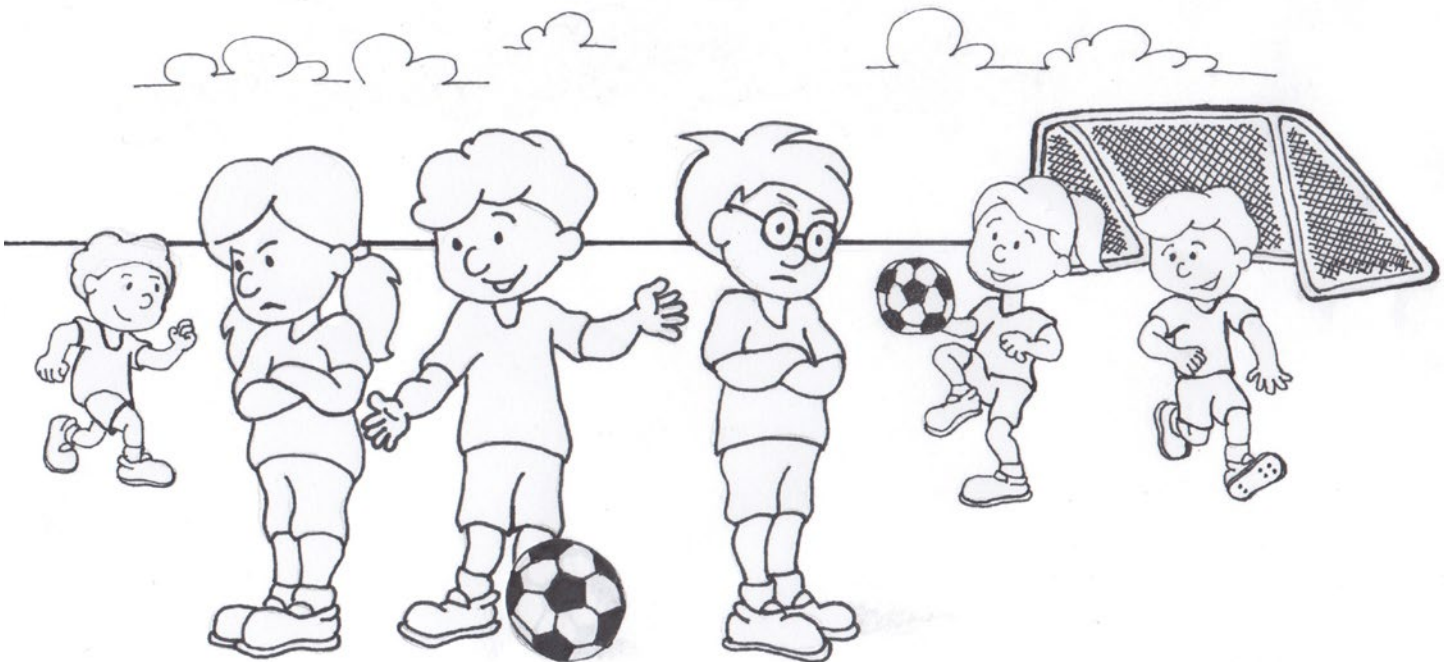

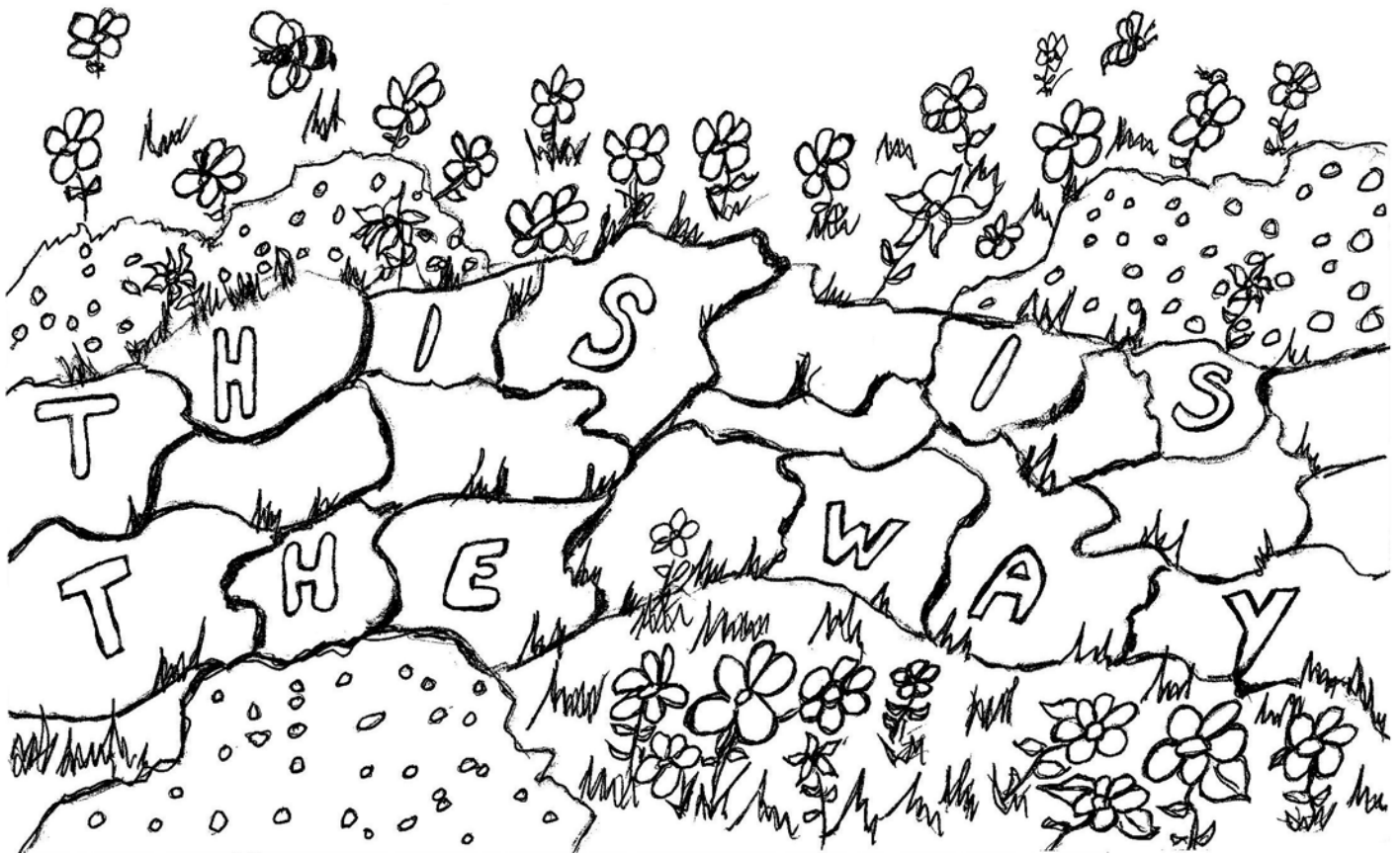

**Color the picture below. This picture depicts the second resurrection.**

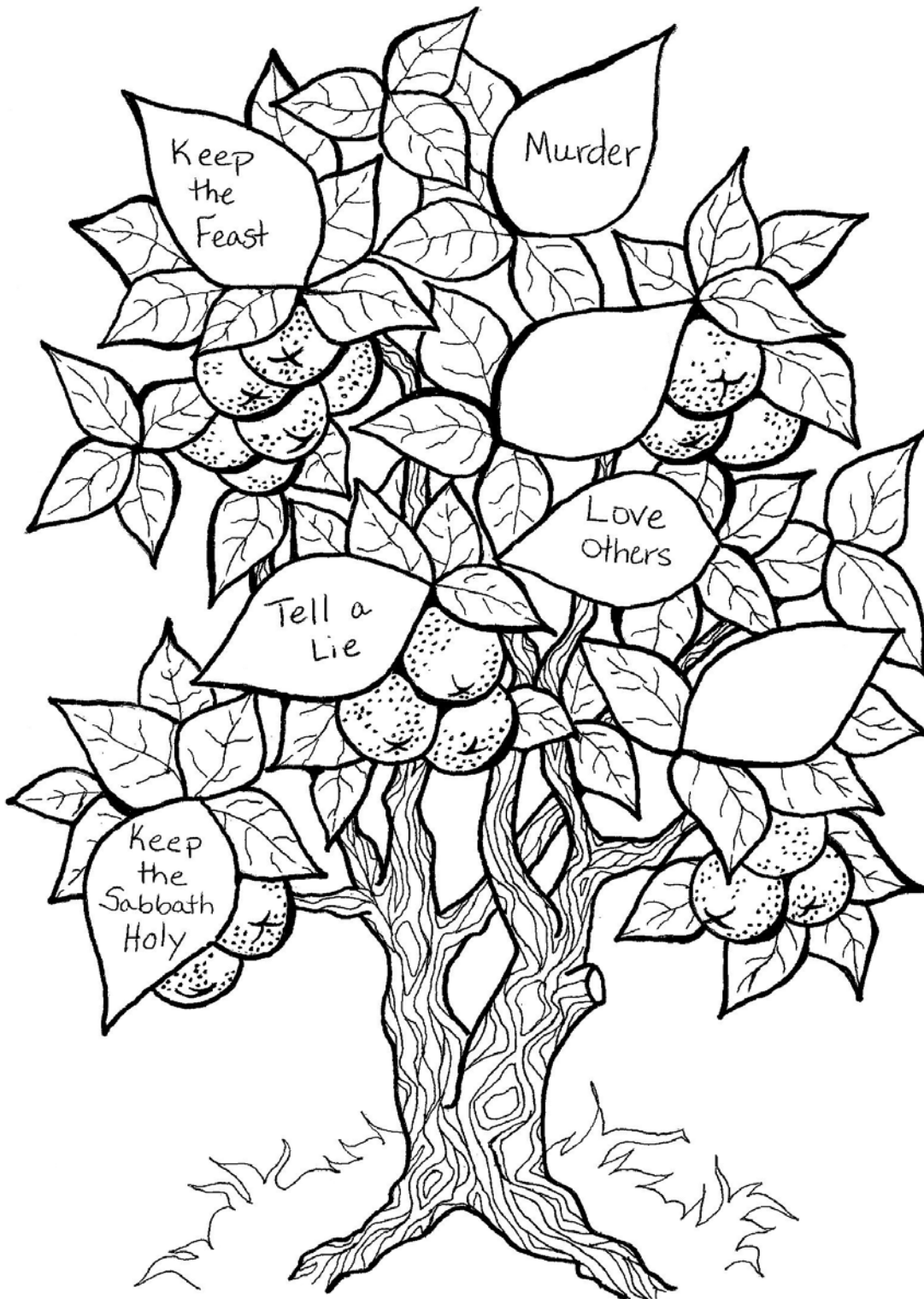

What do you think you could teach others about God?

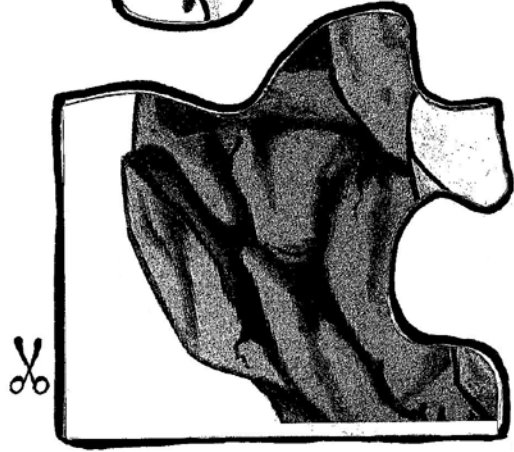
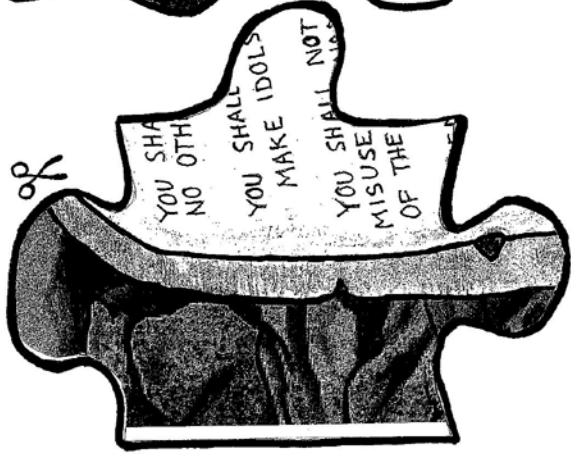
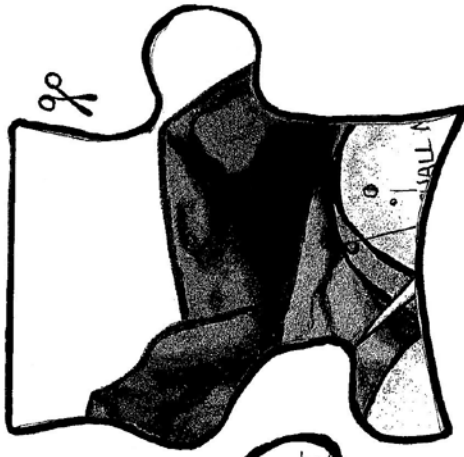
