1. He had a very close personal relationship with God – that's where the spiritual strength came from.

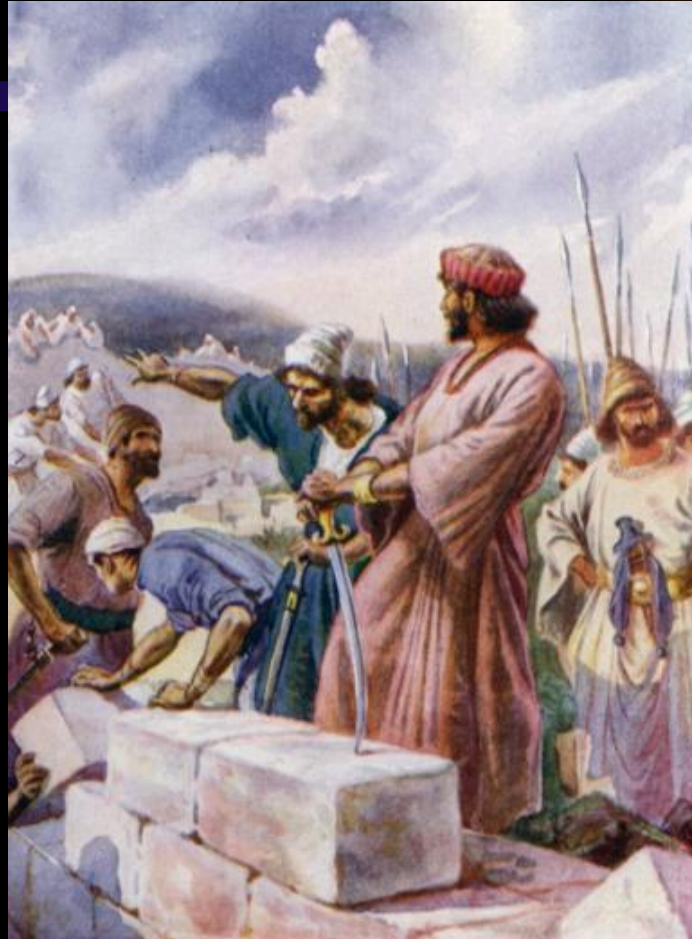
Jer. 9:23-24 – He lived this principle.

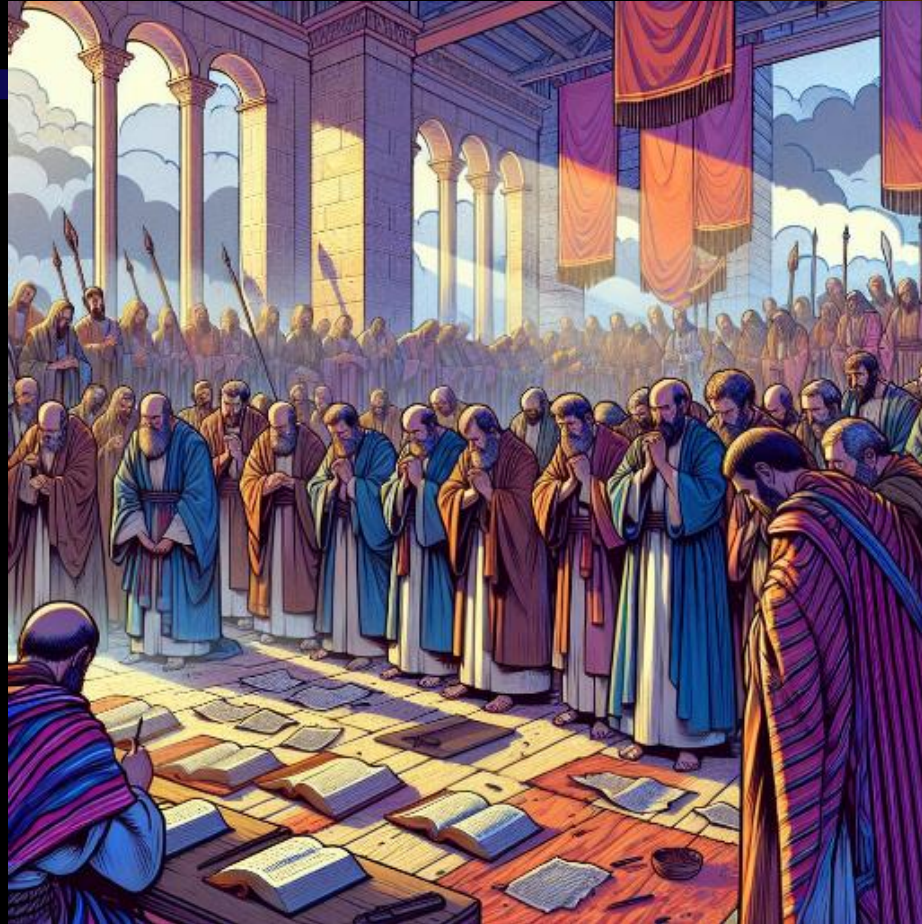


"I am doing a great work, so that I cannot come down. Why should the work cease while I leave it and go down to you?"

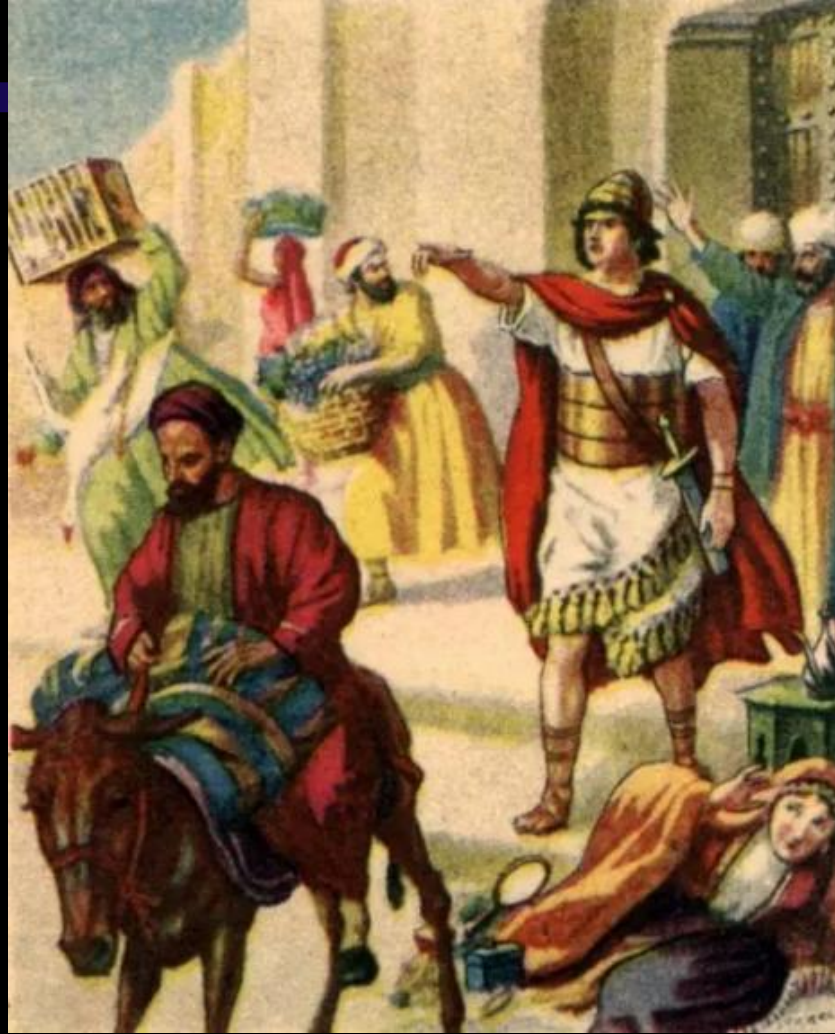
5. He anticipated the problems & not waited for these to come to him, staying close to God – Nehemiah 6:1-19
