What is Behind the Great UAP Disclosure?

There has been a public obsession with UFOs, now called Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena or UAPs. Interest was heightened ever since Kenneth Arnold's sighting of what he dubbed "flying saucers" and the internationally famous 1947 crash at Roswell, New Mexico. These two events more than any cemented the whole idea of UAPs in the public's fascination. The Pentagon began publicly releasing U.S. government UAP videos in 2020, acknowledging their existence. Congress has held hearings on the topic since 2020. In 2026, the U.S. government has taken a major step toward transparency on Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena (UAP) with the Presidential Unsealing and Reporting System for UAP Encounters (PURSUE) now releasing previously classified UAP documents on a regular basis. Where are these UAPs coming from? Are there really extraterrestrials (ETs) from other planets or even distant stars? Are they from Earth and dwelling in subterranean bases or buried deep on the floors of the oceans? What does all this mean, and what are the ramifications for Christians?

The manipulation of the news

Mass media's fakeness is growing worse day by day. Like the "Tower of Babel," the worldwide internet creates confusion. It is intended to cause doubt. Finding the truth in the news is like finding a needle in a hay stack. It is difficult to really hear truth by reading or listening to nearly any news outlet. Global media ownership is highly concentrated with a very small number of multinational corporations, and billionaire families who control the majority of major news sources people access. News is increasingly so liberal, and it nearly always has a slant away from the truth.

It is like finding the rare saints of God and His church, which Jesus Christ said the gates of hell would never prevail against. God's church would never die (Matthew 16:8). Satan has multiplied the counterfeits of the church Jesus raised up. Today, there are over 45,000 different church denominations in the world. Satan, as the author of confusion, has purposely made it that way to hide the truth (I Corinthians 14:33; II Corinthians 4:3-4). Sifting through all of the churches of this world to find the right one is impossible. The prophet Amos foretold a worse time in Amos 8:11: "*Behold, the days are coming,' says the Lord God, 'That I will send a famine on the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord.'*"

The governments and the media have made finding the truth about flying saucers virtually impossible; it is like a house of mirrors at a carnival. Most settle for either half-truths or lies or the latest conspiracy story. The coming Antichrist will use lying wonders to deceive all people. II Thessalonians 2:9-10, tells us the world will believe it: "*The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.*"

Raising more questions

In an article from the *Disclosure Monitor News Desk*, titled, "Newly Released Image Raises Questions About Incident at U.S. Nuclear Weapons Facility": "A newly surfaced government-linked document involving one of America's most sensitive nuclear facilities is beginning to attract serious attention online. The reason? It includes an image tied to an 'Unidentified Object Incident' at Pantex — the primary U.S. facility responsible for assembling and disassembling nuclear weapons. Even more intriguing, the material appears to reference enhancement or analysis involving Sandia National Laboratories, one of America's leading defence and nuclear research institutions. On its own, the image proves nothing extraordinary. But the location involved changes the conversation."

There is no official, publicly confirmed evidence from either the U.S., Russian, or Chinese governments that UAPs have been definitively observed near nuclear weapons deployment zones in those countries. However, credible UAP reports have been documented in the U.S. and other nations, and some of these have occurred in proximity to nuclear infrastructure. There has been no official U.S., Russian, or Chinese report that has indicated that UAPs have disrupted or disabled nuclear launch systems. Naturally, we expect governments to be closed-lipped about any such unexplained disruption of nuclear weapons.

Is disclosure close to happen? Is it a part of the big lie?

While UAPs are observed globally and have been documented for multiple decades, there is no confirmed evidence linking them to extraterrestrial life. At the same time, science fiction movies have flooded the world with movies from, *The Day the Earth Stood Still in 1951*, *Star Trek* in mid 1960s, to *Star Wars* in 1977, and Spielberg's films about spaceships and aliens.

Stephen Spielberg has been a master at making great alien movies. Early in his career, he made two high rated films, *Close Encounters of the Third Kind in November 1977*, and *E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial* in 1982.

Stephen Spielberg's new film carries on the UAP narrative more dramatically. It has a theme of how the world will handle disclosure that ETs exist. Will it turn governments, religions, and races upside-down, and will it divide people? Spielberg said this about his film, *Disclosure Day*, "the most extraordinary event in human history' and one that demands acceptance that we have not been alone since the beginning of time."

Now they are talking about disclosure of UAPs and whether ETs exist. *Time* magazine says, "Now *Disclosure Day*, out June 12 (2026), tells the story of a planet on the brink of world war, where a furtive battle breaks out over what to do with a radical new truth: we are not alone. The debate over whether the disclosure of this information will bring humanity together or fracture it further puts corporate titans, scientists, broadcasters, and even nuns at dangerous odds with one another."

More and more, the entire world has been baited by false narratives by a giant hoax leading society by their imagination down a road to believe in something which is false. Some are actually saying the next step leading up to the return of Christ will be a fake alien invasion of the world.

The 40th president of the United States, Ronald Reagan, longed for world peace and unity. Interestingly, nbcnews.com quoted him saying an unusual thing before the United Nations 26 years ago: "Perhaps we need some outside universal threat to make us recognize this common bond. I occasionally think how quickly our differences worldwide would vanish if we were facing an alien threat from outside this world."

What should the elect be thinking?

What did Jesus say to His disciples as He prophesied the signs of the explosive times of the end of the cosmos, "*See that you be not troubled.*"

In Matthew 24 He explained the extraordinary times when false Christs would arise: "*Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it. For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. See, I have told you beforehand.*" (Matthew 24:23-25)

What would Jesus say about flying saucers and aliens? Let us attempt to recreate what He might tell us, His disciples today: "See that you are not troubled. It is a distraction. If they tell you outrageous things, do not believe it. It is a deception and a lying wonder."

We must trust in God, and remember what Jesus said in Matthew 24:13-14: "*And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. But he who endures to the end shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.*"
