- Feast of Trumpets, 9/12 – Services for the Feast of Trumpets will be held at 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, September 12. *Cincinnati East and North* will meet at 1103 Allen Drive (former TQL offices), Milford, OH 45150.
