Checks should be payable to United Church of God. If you only come in the afternoon services, you can also put your offering in the labeled container that will be available in the back of the hall. The offerings will be receipted by the Home Office.

If you will not be attending the Holy Day in person, you can mail a check or donate online to the Home Office up to a week after the Holy Day. For donating online, go to ucg.org. You will see a yellowish "Give" button, then below that you will see "Donate." Go further down to see "Holy Day Offerings" and follow the instructions.
