Ps. 6:4-5, “Return, O Lord, deliver me! Oh, save me for Your mercies' sake! For in death there is no remembrance of You; in the grave who will give You thanks?”

This is a famous verse and we should remember them in our trials. As *The Bible Knowledge Commentary* mentions, “In his earnest prayer for deliverance, David gave two reasons why God should answer. One is that the Lord should rescue him because of His unfailing love. God had shown Himself again and again to be abundant in loyal love (Heb. *hesed*), so David pleaded for deliverance on the basis of God's character. David said the second reason the Lord should turn to him is because of the absence of praises (*tôdâh*) in the grave. If he died because of his illness, he then could not praise God for delivering him from it. So, David reasoned that if God desired someone to stand in the sanctuary and proclaim that God delivered him, then God would have to do so.” God does love to hear our prayers and our praises to Him!

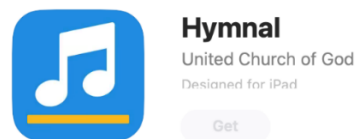

POWERPOINT (PPT) SERMONS UPDATED

By clicking on Downloads, under the title, then select the PPT and right-click to get the option to open it in a new tab or new window to view the PPT alongside the sermon page. It is doubtful to use a smartphone for this because two tabs or windows are necessary for both audio and video functions. These PowerPoint sermons are available from 2020 on. This is not designed to replace our continued print production of the publication, but to add new and enhanced viewing features online using the capabilities of our new website.

When you click on a specific issue, you will see links to individual articles below the welcome statement. While previously only a small selection of articles was visible, requiring that you download the PDF to read the entire publication online, it will now be possible to select all of the content from the Table of Contents below.

Enhanced Photo Galleries and Announcements

Beginning with the January-February 2025 issue of *United News*, you will be able to view items such as photo galleries, member announcements and upcoming events in their own sections. Sections such as "Resources for the Whole Family" include clickable links and graphics and a separate downloadable version of the "Children's Corner" activity. This new format is more mobile-friendly, although a PDF copy of the issue will still be available for your convenience.

Trouble navigating to the page? One easy way to easily access *United News* online is to create a shortcut on your phone's home screen. First, open the United News homepage

(ucg.org/members/united-news), then follow the following instructions:

Creating iPhone Shortcut

In Safari, while at ucg.org/members/united-news, tap the “Share” button (looks like a square with an arrow), then scroll down and select “Add to Home Screen.” You can then customize the name of the shortcut before tapping “Add” to place it on your home screen.

Creating Android Shortcut

7. Ann Tower very kindly offered to keep buying the snacks, plates, cups, creamer, coffee, etc. So, if the region coordinators or assistants notice that some things are running low, please let Ann know so she can add them to her shopping list.

8. Please be patient because there are still some details to solve, but we are very confident that this new plan will work out just fine. There will be more variety of foods and snacks every week, and we'll be able to enjoy the wonderful cooking skills of other people.
