Sabbath Thought

Ps. 7:14-16, "Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity; yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood. He made a pit and dug it out, and has fallen into the ditch which he made. His trouble shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown."

The Knowledge Bible Commentary mentions, "David stated how God traps the wicked with their own plans. If someone conceives trouble, it will not produce its intended results. Rather the evil scheme will be turned back on the plotter (Pr. 26:27). This is retribution from God, for the punishment fits the crime (an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, etc., Ex. 21:24-25). Jesus said that they "who draw the sword will die by the sword" (Mt. 26:52).

FEAST OF TRUMPETS NEXT SABBATH, SEPTEMBER 12

The Feast of Trumpets will be next Sabbath, Sept. 12, at our local church facility. Services will be at 11 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and the offering will be in the morning service. If you wish, you can bring your lunches and eat here at this facility between services. Coffee and tea will be provided. As usual, we will only set up tables and chairs, and participants are asked to do their own cleanup. A list of some nearby restaurants is on the Information Table and on our church website. Note: the Goldenwest Diner has been closed.

OFFERING INFORMATION FOR TRUMPETS

The **Holy Day offering** will be taken in the morning service. If possible, please use the green envelopes provided by the Home Office and write the amount clearly on the front of the envelope. If you don't have your pre-labeled green envelope, please write your name and address on the front of the envelope and if possible write in your 'Pin' number (the number that begins with "U" and is on printed material you receive from UCG. Checks should be payable to United Church of God. If you only come in the afternoon services, you can also put your offering in the labeled container that will be available in the back of the hall. The offerings will be receipted by the Home Office.

Mailing a check or donating online to the Home Office

If you will not be attending the Holy Day in person, you can mail a check or donate online to the Home Office up to a week after the Holy Day. For donating online, go to ucg.org. You will see a yellowish "Give" button, then below that "Donate." Go further down to see "Holy Day Offerings" and follow the instructions.

To send a check, For those who choose to mail their Holy Day offerings, please use the green Holy Day offering envelopes which were mailed to you earlier.
