| <p>1. <b>Gen. 3:14-15:</b> Promise of a “seed” or descendant of Eve to bruise and overcome Satan.</p>   | <p><b>Heb. 2:9, 14-17:</b> Jesus was sent to destroy the power of Satan</p>  |

| <p>3. <b>Deut. 18:15-19:</b> Moses declares a coming Prophet.</p>   | <p><b>Acts 3:13-26;</b> Luke 24:19.</p>  |
| <p>4. <b>Psa. 2:1-12:</b> The Messiah be the Son of God.</p>  | <p>Many NT scriptures attest to Jesus as the Son of God (Mat. 3:17). The apostles applied Psalm 2 to Jesus: <b>Acts 4:23-28.</b></p>                                     |
| <p>5. Psalm 22 is written by David about the anguish in his life. But in the light of the New Testament Psalm 22 is also a prophecy of the suffering Messiah.</p>   |  |
| <p><b>Psa. 22:1-5:</b> His dying words.<br/><b>Psa. 22:6-8:</b> He would be mocked for not saving himself (Psa. 109:25).<br/><b>Psa. 22:9-17:</b> He was to be beaten and crucified (Isa. 50:4-11).<br/><b>Psa. 22:18:</b> They would gamble for his clothing.<br/>Psa. 22:19-31: God’s Kingdom to be established on the earth.</p> | <p><b>Mark 15:33-41.</b><br/>Luke 23:35-37; <b>Mat. 27:39-44.</b><br/><b>Mat. 27:26-28.</b><br/><b>Mat. 27:35;</b> John 19:23-24.</p>                                    |
| <p>6. Psa. 16:10: His body would not decay.</p>   | <p>Mark 16:1-6.</p>  |
| <p>7. Psa. 34:19-20: None of his bones would be broken.</p>   | <p>John 19:32-36.</p>  |
| <p>8. Psa. 69:21: He would be given vinegar to drink (v. 19-20).</p>  | <p>Mat. 27:34, 48; Mk. 15:36; Jn. 19:29.</p>   |
| <p>9. Psa. 68:18: The Messiah to ascend into heaven.</p>  | <p>Acts 1:1-11; Eph. 4:7-10.</p>   |
| <p>10. Psa. 69:9: The Messiah to be</p>   | <p>John 2:13-17.</p>   |

11. Psa. 110:1: The Messiah to sit at  
at the right hand of God. Heb. 1:1-4.

12. Isaiah 52 and 53 are prophecies concerning the Servant of God who would suffer for the sins of mankind.

**Isa. 52:13-15:** He was to be beaten  
and crucified to "sprinkle many nations".

**Isa. 53:1-3:** He was to be rejected of  
men (Psa. 69:4). **Luke 23:13-25;** John 15:25.

**Isa. 53:4-7:** He would keep silent.

**Mark 15:3-5.**

**Isa. 53:8-9:** He would be buried  
"with the rich in his death".

**Mat. 27:57-60.**

**Isa. 53:10-12:** God desired to sacrifice  
the Messiah for all mankind.

John 3:16; Mat. 26:42; Gal. 1:3-4;  
Tit. 2:13-14; 1 Tim.2:5-6; Heb.12:2.

13. **Isa. 7:14-16:** A virgin to bear  
a child ("*Immanuel*" means "*God with us*"). **Mat. 1:18-25.**

14. Isa. 11:1-5, 10: A descendent of Jesse  
father of King David, to open salvation to  
the Gentiles (Isa. 42:1-4; Jer. 23:5-8). Acts 13:22-23; Rom. 15:8-12.

15. Isa. 61:1-3: The Messiah was to  
bring a message of "*good news*". Luke 4:16-21.

16. Isa. 42:1-4; 49:1-7: This message is  
to go to all peoples. Mat. 12:14-21.

17. Micah 5:2: He was to be from  
Bethlehem. Luke 2:4-7.

18. Zech. 9:9: The King would come to  
his people on a donkey. Mark 11:1-11; Mat. 21:12-16:  
"*Hosanna*" means "*Save, we pray*"(Vine's).

19. Zech. 11:10-14: He would be  
betrayed for 30 pieces of silver. Mat. 27:3-10.

20. Zech. 12:9-10: He was to be pierced. John 19:37.

21. Mal. 3:1: Promise of a messenger  
Luke 1:5-25 (67-80); Lk. 7:24-28.to prepare  
the way for the Messiah.
