## **OT PROPHESY**

## NT FULFILLMENT

1. **Gen. 3:14-15:** Promise of a "*seed*" or descendant of Eve to bruise and overcome Satan.

**Heb. 2:9, 14-17:** Jesus was sent to destroy the power of Satan

2. **Gen. 12:1-3; 22:16-18:** Promise that through Abraham's seed all nations to be blessed.

**Luke 1:46-55:** words of Mary mother of Jesus who understood that the child within her was a fulfillment of the promise made to Abraham; **Gal. 3:7-16.** 

3. **Deut. 18:15-19:** Moses declares a coming Prophet.

Acts 3:13-26; Luke 24:19.

4. **Psa. 2:1-12:** The Messiah be the Son of God.

Many NT scriptures attest to Jesus as the Son of God (Mat. 3:17). The apostles applied Psalm 2 to Jesus: **Acts 4:23-28**.

5. Psalm 22 is written by David about the anguish in his life. But in the light of the New Testament Psalm 22 is also a prophecy of the suffering Messiah.

Psa. 22:1-5: His dying words.

**Psa. 22:6-8:** He would be mocked for not saving himself (Psa. 109:25).

**Psa. 22:9-17:** He was to be beaten and crucified (Isa. 50:4-11).

Psa. 22:18: They would gamble for

his clothing.

Psa. 22:19-31: God's Kingdom to be established on the earth.

Mark 15:33-41.

Luke 23:35-37; Mat. 27:39-44.

Mat. 27:26-28.

Mat. 27:35; John 19:23-24.

6. Psa. 16:10: His body would not decay. Mark 16:1-6.

7. Psa. 34:19-20: None of his bones would John 19:32-36. be broken.

8. Psa. 69:21: He would be given vinegar Mat. 27:34, 48; Mk. 15:36; Jn. 19:29. to drink (v. 19-20).

9. Psa. 68:18: The Messiah to ascend

into heaven.

10. Psa. 69:9: The Messiah to be

11. Psa. 110:1: The Messiah to sit at Heb. 1:1-4. at the right hand of God.

12. Isaiah 52 and 53 are prophesies concerning the Servant of God who would suffer for the sins of mankind.

**Isa. 52:13-15:** He was to be beaten and crucified to "sprinkle many nations".

**Isa. 53:1-3:** He was to be rejected of **Luke 23:13-25;** John 15:25.

**Isa. 53:4-7:** He would keep silent. **Mark 15:3-5. Isa. 53:8-9:** He would be buried **Mat. 27:57-60.** 

"with the rich in his death".

**Isa. 53:10-12:** God desired to sacrifice John 3:16; Mat. 26:42; Gal. 1:3-4; the Messiah for all mankind. Tit. 2:13-14; 1 Tim.2:5-6; Heb.12:2.

13. **Isa. 7:14-16:** A virgin to bear **Mat. 1:18-25.** a child ("*Immanuel*" means "*God with us*").

14. Isa. 11:1-5, 10: A descendent of Jesse Acts 13:22-23; Rom. 15:8-12. father of King David, to open salvation to the Gentiles (Isa. 42:1-4; Jer. 23:5-8).

15. Isa. 61:1-3: The Messiah was to Luke 4:16-21. bring a message of "good news".

16. Isa. 42:1-4; 49:1-7: This message is Mat. 12:14-21. to go to all peoples.

17. Micah 5:2: He was to be from Luke 2:4-7. Bethlehem.

18. Zech. 9:9: The King would come to his people on a donkey.

Mark 11:1-11; Mat. 21:12-16:

"Hosanna" means "Save, we pray"(Vine's).

19. Zech. 11:10-14: He would be Mat. 27:3-10. betrayed for 30 pieces of silver.

20. Zech. 12:9-10: He was to be pierced. John 19:37.

21. Mal. 3:1: Promise of a messenger Luke 1:5-25 (67-80); Lk. 7:24-28.to prepare the way for the Messiah.
