**Beyond Today Returns to WGN America, 4/6:** Beginning on Friday, April 6, *Beyond Today* TV will air every week on WGN America, which now reaches 82 million households in all 50 U.S. states. The program will air at 8:30 a.m. ET. (In the Cincinnati Metro area WGN America HD is Channel 74 on Time Warner and Spectrum Cable, Channel 307 on DirecTV, and Channel 239 on DishTV. Cincinnati Bell Fioptics does not carry WGN America. To find the WGN America channel locations in other areas please visit [wgnamerica.com/channel-finder/](http://wgnamerica.com/channel-finder/) and enter your zip code. You will be shown the providers and channel number(s) on which you can watch WGN America.) Please note that as of March 31, *Beyond Today* will end programming on the WORD Network.

**Feast of Tabernacles Sites:** A number of people have been asking about the locations of sites for the Feast of Tabernacles. Most sites are listed on the Feast webpage – [feast.ucg.org](http://feast.ucg.org). Online registration will begin April 15, however there are some sites which require early registration. These two sites are currently open for registration: Anchorage (Alaska) and Jamaica. If you are planning to attend either site, you can begin registering now. You must first sign in to your UCG account or create one to register.
