- o <u>Passover Services, Thursday, 3/29</u> Services will begin at 8:00 p.m. at the Home Office. Members should plan to arrive no earlier than 7:30 p.m. and bring your Bible, plus your own towel and basin for footwashing.
- Night to Be Much Observed, Friday, 3/30 An evening to celebrate the beginning of the Days of Unleavened Bread with a special Sabbath meal and fellowship in private homes or restaurants.
- First Day of Unleavened Bread, Saturday, 3/31 Services will be held at the Home Office at 2:30 p.m. A Holy Day offering will be collected.
- <u>Last Day of Unleavened Bread, Friday, 4/6</u> Services at 10:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. at the Clarion Hotel, 3855 Hauck Road, Cincinnati, OH 45241. Please bring your personal hymnals. A Holy Day offering will be collected during the morning service. Directions are available at the Information Table.
