Peanut Allergies – Fragrance Free Zone

Brethren, we have a need to assist those in our fellowship who have health concerns with peanut products and/or issues dealing with fragrances (most notably colognes and perfumes). We have one in our fellowship that can have such a severe reaction to peanut products that it could cause hospitalization or even death. Those with fragrance issues have a hard time breathing and other

very unpleasant reactions. Let's redouble our efforts to serve those in these situations with the loving care that the Chicago Church is known for.

Prayer Requests:

Samara Brock: Your urgent prayers are deeply appreciated for Samara Brock. The short story is this: Heart issues, Sepsis (white blood cell count is "crazy high"), and bad reactions to Antibiotics. A relatively high-risk Procedure took place this Wednesday, late morning. To remedy the Gastroparesis so she can eat without pain, the Botox injections into the Pylorus muscle appeared to go smoothly. After she awoke, she was without the non-stop pain for the first time (longer than she can remember) except for the pain from some swelling. The PICC line remains and they added the G.J-tube. They released her to go home with certain cautions. She wasn't home for 45 minutes before they were on their way back to the ER from fever 102.5 indicating raging infection. IV Tylenol has now brought the fever down to 101.4 POTS adds to the overall problem with a weakened heart, of course. Her heart has been racing at an alarming rate, sustaining for guite a long while. Discussions over a possible Pace Maker. Undecided yet. The current discussion over likely sepsis is of great concern. This could result in organ failure and death. They've put her on strong antibiotics while in the ER currently, however, she's having a bad reaction to antibiotics with swelling, stiffness, more pain and inability to talk. Many doctors are involved and concerned about this 13 hour pathos, still unfolding. Only God can truly save her. So once again, we look to the Family of God to join us in asking our Father for mercy and saving her alive.
