[Parenting Class "Choosing the Right"](#) April 28

Christ teaches us to desire and choose right actions because they are right. We call this virtue. As parents we help our children identify and choose right ways. (2 Peter 1:5... from faith to virtue). Two Possible Break Out Session Topics (Choose one):

1. In our homework for next week's class we were instructed to listen to a sermon given by Mr. Fahey senior. In that sermon he covered how the Spirit in Man functions in the rearing of our children. Regarding fatherhood he stated that the world has been working against fathers for a very long time. In fact, Satan's society is hostile to authority and, therefore, hostile to fathers who represent authority. He further commented that even some Bibles are now being translated so that they are gender neutral. This is to filter out any "male dominance" and that Hollywood continually shows disrespect for fathers but elevates the young. With this as background here is the question: *What Biblical principles do we have to guide fathers as they fulfill their loving responsibility in the rearing/teaching of their children? As a supporting question, what biblical principles guide mothers as they augment, enhance and support their husbands in their fatherhood role?*

2. By the time we get together into our break out groups we will have gone through two-thirds of our lectures for this class as well as 50 % of the break out sessions. Therefore, I propose a **Wild Card Topic**. This is a topic that each break out group can chose for itself. It may be, but not limited to, a topic that:

- revisits a topic not fully covered by previous break outs;
- covers a topic not brought out in this 4th class;
- covers a topic that appears will not be covered in any of the six classes.
