As you know, Sammy had been having an allergic reaction for a week and a half that suddenly worsened overnight on Friday (last Friday) to the point that he was struggling to breathe. I had already made an appointment for Saturday morning with his doctor but when we arrived the doctor called an ambulance to have Sammy taken to the Emergency Room. Even with a lot of medication, his breathing was not improving after several hours in the ER, and we were told he would need to stay in the hospital overnight. During the night his breathing finally stabilized and by this morning his breathing was much improved. He was still intensely itchy during the night even with all the medication (he has a rash over most of his body) but we were told there is not much else that can be done for that. We were released to go home around 1pm today. Sammy will continue with medications for a while and we are praying that Sammy's rash will resolve soon and not turn into a lifelong issue.
