“Book of Revelation”
Lesson Three

As we saw last time, there is a strong correlation with the Book of Daniel, when studying the Book of Revelation. That symbolism will become more important as we get into the heart of the Book of Revelation later. Now, let’s begin our journey into the Book of Revelation.

- 1. What was the first piece of business for John when writing the Book of Revelation – after the introduction which we’ve already discussed? (Rev. 1)**

- 2. Where was John when he wrote the Book of Revelation, and why? (Rev. 1) (You will have to look elsewhere for the “why?”)**

- 3. What symbolism did John see in Revelation 1?**

- 4. What did the symbolism mean in Revelation 1 – and who was the individual? (What scripture/s would you use to support “who” this individual was?)**

- 5. In reference to the entities mentioned in verses 4 and 11 of Revelation 1 above – were these real locations? If so, explain.**

- 6. What do you think is the significance of the use of “7’s” in Revelation?**
