6. LOCAL BIBLE READING PROGRAM: PENTECOST—ANTICIPATION & AFTERMATH

The two books of the Bible that provide a logical lead-up to Pentecost are the books of Luke and Acts (technically, The Acts of the Apostles). The project is voluntary, but it will provide points of very interesting and beneficial fellowship discussion on the Sabbath.

Luke, a gentile physician, traveled extensively with the apostle Paul. God used him to record one of the four gospel accounts of Christ's life, ministry and death for our sins. He also inspired Luke to write the Book of Acts. This makes the two books of Scripture a logical study of the life and ministry of our Lord and Savior that led to the beginning of God's Church on Pentecost, followed by the growth of God's Church in the first century.
