Greetings brethren,

America's best day of the year is headed our way in a couple of weeks—Thanksgiving.

But Thanksgiving is considered by some a dinosaur holiday when viewed through the myopic perspective of the bulk of our selfish, secular nation. Would that it wasn't so!

Secularism has poisoned the national spirit, eroding the already weakened morality of this great "land of the free." Even the small vestige of biblical morality is fast turning invisible to most Americans.
