**Lloyd Nelson** (Mary D'Alessandro's step dad) has been suffering from Atrial Flutter, a condition in which the heart's upper chambers (atria) beat too quickly.

Lloyd will be going to Mayo Clinic next week for an ultrasound transesophageal echocardiogram to determine if he has a blood clot in his heart. If he does not have a blood clot in his heart he will then have a Direct Current Cardioversion to convert his abnormal heart rhythm to a normal heart rhythm. If he does have a blood clot in his heart he will need to be on blood thinners to dissolve the clot before he can have the Direct Current Cardioversion. Please pray Lloyd will be able to have the Direct Current Cardioversion without the delay of a blood clot and that the doctors will be able to convert his heart rhythm back to normal. Lloyd will be 95 at the end of this month.

Ellis and Gwen La Ravia. Gwen has been in an assisted living facility since last summer. Ellis has visited her on a daily basis. Gwen has not improved very much over the course of the last few months, but she hasn't gotten much worse, with her main problem being the loss of memory and mental acuity. Last Friday evening, we received a call from a concerned member in Scottsdale that Ellis didn't respond well to a phone call, so the member alerted us. Ellis was disoriented when I arrived at his home a few minutes later, and I called 911. Once he arrived at the ER, his alertness returned, but over the next few days, the normal battery of tests revealed he had suffered a small stroke, for which he is being treated. At this time, Ellis is still at Tucson Medical Center, but hopes to be released tomorrow or Friday. He suffers from atrial fibrillation, and his irregular heart rate may have contributed to the stroke, and they haven't been able to control it sufficiently to release him.
