	g. Death angel passing over the house or, if no blood, through the home
3.	Are there any practices connected to Passover we observe today that are not present in some form in the list above or have changed their meaning?
4.	The New Covenant Passover shows that the festivals of the Old Testament have a New Covenant meaning. What are some New Testament scriptures referring to Passover from a New Covenant perspective?
