Prayer Requests:

From Janet Bratincevic. The surgeon says the biopsies indicated the cancer was totally removed and there is no cancer in the few lymph nodes he also removed. He does not recommend any further treatment for cancer at this time. My pain is currently minimal, even without narcotics, and this is a great blessing since the surgeon warned me that this was a very painful surgery and that the pain would last about two weeks. So, thanks be to God that He helped me find other ways to get relief! I have to keep my talking to a minimum because of the pain, but I can talk and the surgeon believes my voice will be normal! My diet still consists of only soft foods, but I can eat! I am able to adequately rest, thanks to Jack and my two girls who have taken turns staying with me. I do have a potential additional problem with non-cancerous salivary gland tumors which will have to be addressed over the next few months. The surgeon recommends their removal, but he is willing to just monitor them. I am concerned because removal could cause some facial nerve damage. These types of tumors generally continue to grow slowly and if I wait too long surgery could become more complicated. Your continued prayers for guidance would be appreciated! Thanks be to God for His mercy and His love and His healing power! Thanks be to God for my dear friends! I appreciate your all of the help and support, and especially your prayers in my behalf.

John Barbush's Nephew. *My 14 year old nephew, Isaac Vierra, son of Amy Warrington-Vierra was involved in a terrible accident a week ago. An explosion from a School Science Project that went wrong took off a portion of his left hand, including two and a half fingers and most of his thumb. A series of miracles have already taken place. He has had two surgeries so far and several more to occur. He's home now under pain medications. Upcoming surgeries involve the rebuilding of his thumb, skin grafts, and more. Because of the complexity of these surgical wounds, we are praying specifically for re-vascularization (good blood flow), no infection, and that his sense of feeling and touch is completely restored. Urgent concern is that his hand is purple indicating no blood circulation. If this doesn't change soon, amputation may be required. Now, as of today, during a two hour bandage changing, Amy noticed what had been purple is now pink. Divine intervention is evident, again! We are grateful for the prayers being offered up to our Father in heaven on Isaac's behalf. Thank you all for your loving kindness during this tragedy. Cecily Gillespie's brother Matthew has been improving and was moved this afternoon to a skilled nursing facility. He is still in the process of adjusting to the ileostomy but has resumed eating and has been getting stronger. In the meantime, Jim Gillespie has been having some difficulty with his liver and perhaps pancreas. In addition there are some GI difficulties. This was affecting his energy levels causing him to be very tired. There has been some improvement over the past few days which he and Cecily are very thankful for.
