Samuel and Amy Vierra share this update about the ongoing recovery for their son Isaac, who suffered a severe injury to his left hand in February: "This week, God has heard our prayers for healing and lower pain levels. Isaac's wounds are continuing to show progress and his pain levels are down from an 8 to a 6. He has surgery scheduled Monday for the removal of the 5 pins in his hand. Post-surgery, he will have elevated pain levels for a week or so. After this surgery, we are hopeful that the next surgery won't be until late May or early June. Isaac's spirits are lifted by the heartfelt cards we receive every day. Thank you so much for your love, concern and outpouring of prayers to our Father in Heaven!"
