Singing has been an integral part of godly worship through the ages - from the angels singing at the creation of the earth (Job 38:7) to the children of Israel singing praise to God for deliverance from the Egyptian army (Exodus 15), to brethren in the New Testament being instructed to "sing and make melody to God in their hearts. (Ephesians :19)."

3) Why kind of music is appropriate for worshipping God and honoring Him? I Chronicles 16: 9, 23, Psalms 9:2, Colossians 3:16

- 4) How is Godly music identified? Philippines 4:8, I John 2:15
- 5) What are some Biblical examples where music was used for specific purposes? Matthew 26:30, Zephaniah 3:17, Exodus 15, Acts 16:25
- 6) Share how godly music has inspired, encouraged or impacted you.
