<ul> <li>So far we have completed the prophetic description of the events symbolized by</li> </ul>
the Feast of Trumpets [Christ's coming and the 1st resurrection],
the Day of Atonement [Satan being put away],
the Feast of Tabernacles [the Millennium] and
the Eighth Day, which is the last festival of God's seven festivals of God, and which symbolizes the 2 <sup>nd</sup> resurrection and events beyond into eternity.
<ul> <li>Rev 20:5 – The rest of the dead are resurrected to         a second physical life after the millennium.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>These never had a chance to know God, and so will have their <u>first chance</u> (<u>opportunity</u>) to understand the meaning of true repentance and the commitment which must be made with God because of His grace.</li> </ul>
• Rom 11:1-10 – These were spiritually blind all their lives.
This is a GREAT MYSTERY (v25), because the world does not keep God's Feasts.



## Everyone will have their chance! Those who live today (from the time of Adam and Eve) and are not spiritually blind, who are called, elected and remain faithful to the end (until the second coming of Christ) will be resurrected at Christ's second coming – the 1st resurrection. Rev 11:15 – This is when the Thingel sounds "the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ" The Kingdom of God will now reign on earth. Rev 11:18 – "The nations will be angry ... And [it is] the time of the dead that they should be judged, and that You should reward Your servants..." 1 Cor 15:52 – "At the last trumpet the dead will be raised incorruptible." Rev 14:1, 3-4 – These 144.000 were not contaminated with false religions (religious syncretism and/or any other type of religious infidelity / disobedience). "These are redeemed among men being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb".

## These are the Firstfruits (Redeemed) • Do NOT confuse between "the firstfruits of the Spirit" [NOW] and the "redeemed among men which are the firstfruits" to God and Christ [AT THE RESURRECTION]. • Rom 8:23 – "we also who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption [sonship – gr 5206 - huiothesia], the redemption of our body." • This is US NOW – we HAVE today the firstfruits of the Spirit – which is symbolic of the two wave loaves WITH LEAVEN (Pentecost) waiting for the REDEMPTION (Trumpets). • James 1:18 – We are a "kind of firstfruits of His creatures" – a foretaste now of what we will be at the 1st resurrection! • This is the period of the "sanctification of the Spirit" (1 Pet 1:2; 2 Thes 2:13-14). Symbolized by the time between Pentecost and Trumpets – to persevere till the end! • Rev 17:14 – They are the ones that remained FAITHFUL till the end and will be with Christ when the "nations make war with the Lamb".

Rev 19:9 – The redeemed firstfruits will partake of the marriage supper of the Lamb.



## Rev. 20:11-12 – Those who live today and are spiritually blind will have their first chance (during the 2nd resurrection which will occur after the millennium – Rev 20:5). This will be during the day of judgment (Mat 11:20-24; 12:41-42). It will be a probation period of (possibly) 100 years (Is. 65:20; Ezek 37:1-14). Those who live through the millennium will have their opportunity during Christ's millennial reign.



# • What will happen to people who live today, are NOT spiritually blind and have NOT remained faithful to the end? • In other words ... WHAT HAPPENS TO THE WICKED? (Those who did not repent, after they had a chance to repent; or had a temporary repentance after acquiring the knowledge of the Truth, but turned back; did not remain virgins; were not faithful to the end.)

  2 Peter 3:1-7 the day of judgment and destruction of wicked men.

  2 Peter 3:8-9 God is patient and gives us time to repent.

  2 Peter 3:10, 12 The whole world will melt!

  Every physical vestige of man's sin, which lasted thousands of years, will be completely destroyed.

- V11 Therefore --- Here is WHY P Y: We are to live in "holy conduct and godliness".
- V11 Therefore Here is WHY PROPHECY: We are to live in "holy conduct and godling".
   Holy = Set apart from the world! No syncretism! Without any "infidelity"!
   Mat 5:21-47 Spiritual infidelity includes what we do, what we say, and what we think.
- Godliness = strive to become like God is → You shall [ultimately] be perfect (Mat 5:48).

## The wicked will be destroyed.

- Those that are **NOT FAITHFUL** till the end are condemned to eternal death.
- BUT NOTE: All will be resurrected! (Good and Bad).
- John 5:21, 26-29 All <u>the dead</u> will hear the voice of Jesus Christ and will be resurrected.
- 1 Cor 15:21-22 As in Adam all die, so also all will be made alive.
- These UNFAITHFUL ones, once resurrected, are condemned to death, therefore they are called "Death and modes."
  Rev 20:13-15 are judged one by one <u>each one</u> individually!
  There will be NO more "finger pointing", NO blaming someone else! NO excuses!
  This is what we call the "3rd resurrection" the resurrection of the wicked.

- Luke 16:19-26 Lazarus and the rich tane!
   Rev 3:14-22 Repent while there is still time!
   Luke 21:36 "Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand [in the 1st resurrection] before the Son of Man."
