Security

Like every country, Jamaica has its fair share of crime. Please follow the same safety precautions you would follow in any other country. Those under 13 should always be with an adult and never go into anyone's hotel room who is unknown. Everyone should use the Buddy System. If approached with dubious offers, utter a polite but firm "no thank you" without stopping or slowing down. Ignore catcalls; keep walking briskly and with purpose. Never go off with any unfamiliar person outside of our group—especially alone.
