

Creating an Account

Go to http://www.ucg.org.

Click **Sign In | Sign Up** in the upper right corner of the window.



Note: If you are unsure whether you have an account on ucg.org, click "Request new password" from the Sign In/Sign Up page, enter your likely email address, and click "E-mail new password." If your email address is recognized, you will receive instructions via email on how to reset your password. If your email address is not recognized, continue with the Sign Up process.

Create a **username** for your new account.


Spaces are allowed; punctuation is not allowed except for periods, hyphens, apostrophes, and underscores.

Enter and confirm a **password** for this account. Your password must be at least 6 characters.





In your Profile, you can enter your first and last name, create a biography, add a photo, change your e-mail address/password, and update your Preferences (enable/disable messages, set time zone).


Please update your Profile to include at least your first and last name and a photo to help others recognize you.

Click **Account Settings** to edit your Profile.







Click **Change My Picture** to add or update your Profile photo.




Click **Choose File** to select an image from your computer.




Click the **Upload** button to preview your image on the screen.




Click the **Save** button to add the image to your Profile.
